COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Harassment; Restraining Order - Violate and knows of temporary or restraining order

Minnesota Statute: 609.748.6(b)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/31/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000624

Charge Description: John Cyriel Kor

On or about May 31, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, John Cyriel Kor did violate a restraining order issued under M.S. 609.748.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 31, 2016, at approximately 7:59 a.m., Victim 1 met Officer Larson of Tri-City Police Department at the Good Thunder Police Department to explain that her ex, later identified as John Cyriel Kor, the defendant herein, violated a harassment restraining order ('HRO'). Victim 1 stated the violations occurred through text messages, calls, and Facebook. Officer Larson explained that he would meet her to file a report.

On June 6, 2016, Officer Larson met with Victim 1 to discuss the aforementioned incident. Victim 1 stated that she wanted to file a report and show Officer Larson her phone. After looking at Witness 1's phone, Officer Larson determined that there was a missed call from the defendant and a few minutes after the call, a subsequent text message from the defendant to Victim 1's phone on May 31, 2016. Victim 1 showed Officer Larson the HRO paperwork and noted that on the second page the defendant is to not have any contact, direct or indirect, with Victim 1. The HRO was filed on March 2, 2016; a copy of which was attached to Officer Larson's report.

On April 11, 2016, the defendant commented on Victim 1's business Facebook page and Victim 1 reported that the defendant called her at work a few times as well. Again on May 31, 2016, the defendant called and messaged Victim 1 on her personal cellphone. Victim 1 took a still screenshot on each occasion; copies of which were attached to Officer Larson's report. Victim 1 stated that she previously involved Mankato Police at one point regarding this Defendant.

The HRO is in effect until March 1, 2018; and therefore, was in effect on the date of incident. The order granting the HRO includes no direct or indirect contact with Victim 1, including phone calls and contact via electric means such as social networking sites.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
