On or about February 10, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Manachanwa Mark Ogud did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle, when his/her alcohol concentration at the time, or as measured within two hours of the time, of driving, operating or being in physical control of the motor vehicle was 0.08 or more.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 10, 2016, at approximately 5:25 a.m., Officer Courtney Walker, of the Mankato Department of Public Safety, was dispatched to a location in Mankato, Blue Earth County, in regards to an ongoing domestic assault. The complainant stated, 'She is killing her mom.' It was also reported there was a knife involved in the incident.

Upon arriving at the scene Officer Walker observed a tan Chevy Blazer, license number 096 GDC, exiting the apartment complex onto Homestead Road. Officer Walker informed Officer Hullopeter that it was the same vehicle that was associated with a domestic assault that had happened the previous evening, and that he knew the registered owner to be Manachawa Mark Ogud, date of birth December 15, 1992. Ogud had been involved in a domestic late the previous evening, and officers currently had probable cause to arrest him for that assault as they had been looking for him since late the previous evening.

Officer Walker made contact with Adult1 who stated that Ogud was his son, and that Ogud had entered their residence armed with a large knife and threatened to kill his mother, Adult2. Adult1 stated the knife was approximately as large and as long as his forearm. Adult1 stated Ogud had left the apartment prior to Officer Walker's arrival. Adult1 thought it appeared as though Ogud was on drugs.

Officer Walker then made contact with Adult2 who was in the bathroom of the apartment. At the time, Adult2 was holding a small child and was hyperventilating. Adult2 was unable to speak due to her medical condition. Adult1 stated that he could tell Officer Walker what had happened as he had observed everything.

Adult1 stated that at approximately 5:22 a.m., Ogud arrived at the apartment and came into his bedroom with a large knife in his right hand and asked where Adult2 was. Ogud then went into Adult2's bedroom and attempted to open the door and threatened to kill Adult2 several times. Adult1 stated Adult2 was holding the small child in her arms while this took place. Adult1 stated that Ogud threatened Adult2 several times, and Adult2 began to scream as Ogud presented the long knife blade in a downward stabbing motion with his right hand. Adult1 stated Adult2 was screaming and obviously afraid. Adult1 then grabbed the phone and ran outside of the apartment to call 911.

Adult1 stated Ogud then ran toward him with the long knife still in his right hand and began threatening to kill Adult1 several times. Adult1 stated he was afraid for his life and backed away from Ogud. Adult1 stated he yelled at Ogud and told Ogud that he had called the police which caused Ogud to vacate the residence.

After Gold Cross Ambulance cleared Adult2, Officer Walker spoke to her. Adult2 stated that she heard Ogud screaming at Adult1 in his room so she got up. Adult2 stated she was holding the small child because the child sleeps with her. Adult1 stated she opened her bedroom door and Ogud turned toward her and attempted to force his way into the room. Adult2 stated she was able to keep the door closed until Ogud left the residence and she then slipped into the bathroom and hid there with the door locked. Adult2 stated that Ogud was holding a long knife in his right hand with the blade pointing down. Adult2 stated Ogud was making a stabbing motion while threatening to kill her in a loud and aggressive voice. Adult2 stated that Ogud threatened her several times over and over. Adult2 stated there were two other children in the apartment that were locked in their bedrooms while this took place.

Officer Hullopeter followed the tan Chevy Blazer out of the parking lot as Officer Walker went to the residence. Officer Hullopeter activated his squad car lights and attempted to perform a traffic stop on Ogud. However, Ogud continued eastbound on Homestead Road. Officer Hullopeter activated his squad car siren. Ogud continued to drive eastbound without stopping. Other vehicles then arrived and followed

behind Officer Hullopeter.

Ogud turned southbound on Pohl Road and maintained speeds at approximately 30 miles per hour. Ogud then turned eastbound on Stadium Road and turned southbound on Highway 22. All the while police cars were following him with their lights and sirens activated. Ogud then accelerated rapidly at speeds up to 70 miles per hour. As Ogud was traveling on Highway 22 he braked rapidly to a complete stop in an apparent attempt to crash into the squad cars. Ogud then accelerated again and a few moments later came to an abrupt stop again.

After Ogud stopped he immediately exited the vehicle and officers could see a large knife in his hand. The knife was held with the blade facing down with his arm bent and raised. Ogud then walked toward Officer Baker's squad car and was yelling at the officers to kill him. Ogud came within a few feet of Officer Baker's squad car.

Officer Schnorenberg was able to see that Ogud did not have a firearm in his possession, so he got out of his vehicle and approached Ogud from the back of Officer Baker's squad on the driver's side. At that time, he could hear Ogud saying, 'Kill me, kill me, just kill me.' Knowing that the other officers would have their firearms pointed at Ogud, Officer Schnorenberg approached Ogud with his Taser. He then commanded Ogud several times to get on the ground, but Ogud continued to say he wanted the officers to kill him. Officer Schnorenberg fired two Taser cartridges at Ogud, and Ogud fell to the ground. Officers were then able to subdue Ogud and get him handcuffed. Ogud was taken into custody and his vehicle was searched. Officer Schnorenberg recovered two empty Bud Lite beer cans on the floor in the backseat.

Officer Baker transported Ogud to get checked out at the hospital. While making contact with Ogud, Officers detected a heavy odor of alcohol coming from Ogud. He also observed that Ogud's speech was slurred, eyes were bloodshot, and he continued to repeat the same statements and questions repeatedly. Officer Hullopeter obtained a search warrant to collect a blood sample from Ogud. Before taking the blood sample, officers obtained a preliminary breath test from Ogud that showed an alcohol concentration of 0.134. Officers informed Officer Hullopeter of this before he obtained the search warrant. The search warrant was signed by The Honorable Bradley Walker, of Blue Earth County District Court; and a blood sample was taken from Ogud.

While Officer Baker was transporting Ogud, Ogud stated that if the officers didn't kill him, he was going to kill himself; and that he wasn't going to hurt his mother, he was just upset that she never took his side. Ogud stated he had been kicked out of his apartment which upset him because he paid bills. Ogud was referring to the domestic assault that had taken place late the previous evening.

A record check revealed that Ogud has prior qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency from November 2009 in court file 07-JV-09-3500 for Third Degree Assault, from August 2010 in court file 07-JV-10-1543 for Domestic Assault, from May 2006 in court file 07-JV-06-400 for Domestic Assault, and from May 2006 in court file 07-JV-06-813 for Domestic Assault.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
