The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer in a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and one day or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/30/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20001933

Charge Description: On or about December 30, 2020, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Paul Peter Jal did by means of a motor vehicle, flee or attempt to flee a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, and the perpetrator knows or should reasonably know the same to be a peace officer.

COUNT II

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer By a Means Other Than a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.6

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 12/30/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20001933

Charge Description: On or about December 30, 2020, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Paul Peter Jal, did, for the purpose of avoiding arrest, detention, or investigation, attempted to evade or elude a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, by means of running, hiding or any other means other than fleeing in a motor vehicle.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On December 30, 2020 at 3:47 pm Officers with the Mapleton Police Department were investigating a suspect identified as Paul Peter Jal, DOB 02/12/1999, for possible threats made. Officer Hagen and Officer Davis identified Jal as being present at Commercial Business 1 in a vehicle with expired tabs and possibly illegally tinted windows. Officer Davis and Officer Hagen both attempted a traffic stop on the vehicle.

Officer Davis observed the vehicle begin to accelerate and then lose control and spin around causing it to back into the boulevard in the snow. Officer Hagen attempted to block the vehicle in. Then Officer Davis observed the tires of the vehicle spin and the vehicle was able to get out of the snow. The vehicle accelerated around Officer Hagen's squad unit and back into the roadway. It continued to accelerate south on Central Avenue toward Silver Street. Jal continued to cross the intersection without stopping for the stop sign. After the stop sign, Jal lost control of his vehicle and hit the snow embankment and the curb.

Jal exited his vehicle and ran on foot through the backyards. Law enforcement pursued him on foot and continued to give commands to have him stop. They used his name and giving their commands. Jal was ultimately stopped by law enforcement and taken into custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
