COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Demonstrable bodily harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(c)(1)

Maximum Sentence:

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/04/2016

Charge Description: Lloyd Joseph-Michael Skluzacek

On or about November 4, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Lloyd Joseph Michael Skluzacek did, physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law and the assault inflicted demonstrable bodily harm or the person intentionally throws or otherwise transfers bodily fluids or feces at or unto the officer.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Brent Gagnon, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on November 4, 2016, at approximately 8:53 p.m., he and other officers responded to a residence located in the City of Mankato for a welfare check.

When officers arrived, they met with Lloyd Joseph Michael Skluzacek and another individual identified as Witness 1. Both individuals were standing at the end of their driveway. Witness 1's mother, identified as Witness 2, stated she had received a call from both parties asking for help.

Skluzacek and Witness 1 appeared to be extremely intoxicated. Gagnon reports both displayed bloodshot, glossy eyes, slurred speech, an inability to follow simple directions, an inability to balance, and each emitted a strong odor consistent with alcoholic beverages.

Eventually, both individuals were given a preliminary breath test during which Witness 1 tested at a .40 plus and Skluzacek tested a .315.

Officers then transported both parties to Mayo Clinic Health System Mankato for a medical clearance per detox's request.

Gagnon reports once at the hospital, Skluzacek struck Gagnon with a closed left fist in the right eye/nose area. Gagnon reports he could immediately begin to feel his right eye and nose area begin to swell.

After a struggle, officers were able to secure Skluzacek; and he was taken into custody. After being cleared medically, he was then transported to the Blue Earth County Jail.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
