The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Predatory Offender-Knowingly Violates Registration Req. or Intentionally Provides False Information

Minnesota Statute: 243.166.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/10/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000969

Charge Description: Timothy Alan Sack Also Known As Timothy Alan Allen

On or about September 10, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Timothy Alan Sack, did, as a predatory offender, fail to notify any corrections agent or law enforcement authority five business days before living and/or obtaining a new primary address or secondary address.

COUNT II

Charge: Predatory Offender - Fails to Mail Verification Form w/ 10 Days or Report During Month of Birth

Minnesota Statute: 243.166.4(e)(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/10/2016

Charge Description: Timothy Alan Sack Also Known As Timothy Alan Allen

On or about September 10, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant Timothy Alan Sack did as a registered predatory offender, fail to mail the completed and signed verification form to the Bureau of

Criminal Apprehension within ten days after receipt of the form.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 10, 2016, Officer Joyce Johnson of the Tri-City Police Department was notified that Timothy Alan Sack, D.O.B. 2-13-1964, had an active felony warrant out of Blue Earth County. Sack is a registered predatory offender who has listed his primary address as 131 North Ewing Street in Good Thunder, Blue Earth County. Officer Johnson went to Sack's registered address and knocked on both doors. No one answered the doors, and it appeared that no one was home at the time. As Officer Johnson was walking back to the squad car, she noticed a neighbor across the street. Officer Johnson asked the neighbor if she had seen Sack recently. The neighbor stated that she watches Sack's house all the time because she does not trust the occupants of the residence. The neighbor stated she has not seen Sack in approximately three weeks. The neighbor stated she used to see Sack on a daily basis; but now, there were other people that keep coming and going from Sack's residence.

Officer Johnson stopped back at Sack's registered address several hours later when she noticed a black truck parked in the driveway that was not familiar to her. Officer Johnson knocked on the door, and Scott Pritchard answered. Scott Pritchard stated that he is friends with Sack and is staying at Sack's house while Sack is gone. Pritchard stated he did not know where Sack was at the time. Pritchard stated he does not have any communication with Sack. Pritchard stated that before Sack left, he had texted Pritchard to tell him that Sack was going to Brainerd and then possibly South Dakota. Pritchard stated that Sack asked him to stay at his house because the last time Sack was gone, his house was burglarized.

Officer Johnson asked Pritchard when was the last time Sack lived at Sack's registered address. Pritchard stated that Sack left approximately a month prior to that day. At that time, Officer Johnson noticed that Mark Pritchard was also in the house. Mark Pritchard had an active warrant for his arrest, so Officer Johnson took him into custody. Mark Pritchard stated that Sack did not live in Good Thunder. Mark Pritchard stated that Sack mainly stays in Rochester. Mark Pritchard stated that Sack left on his motorcycle several weeks ago and stated he was going to South Dakota.

On September 12, 2016, Officer Johnson went back to 131 North Ewing Street in Good Thunder, Blue Earth County, to get more information from Scott Pritchard. Scott Pritchard claimed he did not know who Sack left with or any other information. Scott Pritchard again said that Sack left about a month ago and that Sack said he might be going to Brainerd and then the west. Scott Pritchard claimed he had not heard from Sack since that time. Officer Johnson asked Scott Pritchard if Scott Pritchard pays Sack rent for staying in his house. Scott Pritchard stated he did not. Scott Pritchard stated he did not know where Sack was, and Scott Pritchard would not tell Officer Johnson anyway.

Officer Johnson ran a check on Sack's predatory offender registration status. At that time, Officer Johnson observed that Sack was sent a verification letter on August 22, 2016. Sack had not yet returned that verification letter which is required to be returned within ten days.

At this time, Sack's whereabouts are unknown; and he has an active warrant out of Blue Earth County; thus, a warrant is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
