**COMPLAINT**

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 2nd Degree - Possess 25 grams or more cocaine or methamphetamine**

Minnesota Statute: 152.022.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.022.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 25 years and/or \$500,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/01/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20010173

Charge Description: Angie Annitte Albertson

On or about May 1, 2020, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Angie Annitte Albertson did, unlawfully possess one or more mixtures of a total weight of 25 grams or more containing cocaine or methamphetamine.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Agent Kevin Waterstreet, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota, currently assigned to the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force, reports that on May 1, 2020, he was contacted by the Mankato Department of Public Safety regarding a narcotics investigation.

Waterstreet was informed that a hotel located in the City of Mankato had located controlled substances in one of their rooms and requested that an officer come to retrieve them.

Mankato Officer Mathiowetz went to gather the items from the hotel.

Hotel staff informed Mathiowetz that a female named Angie, later identified as Angie Albertson had come to the hotel in an attempt to gather personal items from the room.

When she was told she could not gather anything from the room, Albertson left the room.

Waterstreet reports Mathiowetz gathered two coin-style purses containing a large amount of purported methamphetamine from hotel staff and brought it back to the Public Safety Center as evidence.

Waterstreet reports he subsequently arrived at the Public Safety Center to gather the coin purses as well as a black Under Armor backpack and transported them to the Blue Earth County Justice Center for evidence processing.

Once in the evidence processing room, Waterstreet removed the individually wrapped baggies from each coin purse and immediately observed a felony amount of purported methamphetamine. The white crystalized substance was field-tested and tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

Waterstreet then weighed all the baggies containing methamphetamine on a non-certified digital scale for a total weight of approximately 45.5 grams.

On May 4, 2020, Waterstreet made contact with Albertson at the Blue Earth County Jail and she agreed to speak with him.

After being read her Miranda Warning, Albertson admitted that the two coin purses located by hotel staff containing methamphetamine belonged to her.

She further stated that she purchased the methamphetamine from Lahai Kamara inside room 103. Albertson stated she purchased an ounce of methamphetamine for \$550. Albertson stated she provided \$550 to Kamara and put the methamphetamine inside the coin purses.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
