COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Damage to Prop-1st Deg-Value Reduced Over \$1000

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/04/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15030856

Charge Description: Joshua James Wallin

On or about October 4, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Joshua James Wallin did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 4, 2015, at 8:41 p.m., Officer Fischbach, of the Mankato Department of Public Safety, responded to Grovebrook Circle, in the city of Mankato, for a report of criminal damage to a motor vehicle.

As Officer Fischbach arrived on scene he spoke to the complainant, Adult1. Adult1 stated approximately one hour ago her husband, Joshua James Wallin, the defendant herein, arrived at her house and was upset with her. According to Adult1 she stated she asked Wallin to leave, and he entered the garage to leave the residence where she had parked her 2003 Honda Pilot with Minnesota license plate 544 DGJ. A short while later, Adult1 was leaving to buy new locks for the residence when she noticed that someone keyed her vehicle. Adult1 stated Wallin was the only one that had access to her vehicle during that period of time. Adult1 stated she would get a quote for the damage on the vehicle which she subsequently provided indicating that the cost to repair the vehicle was \$1,532.09 due to the keying on the front door, rear door, quarter panels, and bumpers.

Officer Fischbach contacted Wallin and asked him about the incident. Wallin stated he did go over to their house that they both own together to get some items and that he walked in on Adult1 with another male. Wallin indicated that he was upset and left the residence. Wallin denied keying the vehicle.

Officer Fischbach took photos of the vehicle which showed it had been keyed on all sides of the vehicle and that the damage to repair or replace was in excess of \$1,000.00.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
