COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Damage to Property-3rd Deg-Reduce Value \$501-\$1000

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/28/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16032659

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Alex James Stockman, did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$500 but no more than \$1,000, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

COUNT II

Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/28/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16032659

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Alex James Stockman, did in a public or private place, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know that it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Bill Reinbold and others identified herein.

On October 28, 2016 at approximately 1:35 am, a College Town security officer, Witness 1, was on duty and in the area of 1800 Block Pohl Rd. in Mankato, Blue Earth County. He observed an individual, later identified as Alex James Stockman, the defendant, jump on the hood of a Toyota parked in front of house 90 of the College Town property, and shatter the windshield. Witness 1 approached the defendant and asked him if that was his car. The defendant replied that it was. When witness 1 asked him again if it really was his car, the defendant stated 'no' and started to walk away. Witness 1 asked him to stop so he could talk to him. The defendant replied 'catch me' and led witness one on a chase across the street, between houses, and through yards. The defendant tripped and witness 1 was able to catch him where he held him on the ground until Witness 2 was able to reach them and assist Witness 1. Witness 1 and 2 attempted to handcuff the defendant however the defendant would not cooperate and continued to resist their efforts and struggle with them. The defendant turned toward witness wrote one and stated he was going to 'kick his ass'. A tenant from a nearby house assisted by trying to speak to the defendant to calm him down and advised him to quit resisting. Witness 1 to the defendant back to the car and called 911. Officer Rheingold responded and met witness 1 and the defendant at the scene. The officer observed and took photographs of the shattered windshield on the Toyota. The defendant told the officer that he broke the window and that he was sorry. While speaking with the defendant the officer noted that the defendant was obviously intoxicated and a later PBT measured the defendant's alcohol concentration to be .224.
