COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-Take/Drive Motor Vehicle-No Owner Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(17), with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years and/or \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/11/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16001812

Charge Description: Corey Allen Collmann Also Known As Cory Allen Collmann, Corey Allan Collmann And Corey Allen Collmann

On or about August 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Corey Allen Collmann did take or drive a motor vehicle without the consent of the owner or an authorized agent of the owner, knowing or having reason to know that the owner or an authorized agent of the owner did not give consent.

COUNT II

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Collmann, did receive, possess, transfer, buy, or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery and the value of the property received is a motor vehicle.

Charge: Giving Peace Officer False Name-of Another Person

Charge: Drugs - Synthetic Cannabinoid - Possess any amount of a synthetic cannabinoid

Minnesota Statute: 152.027.6(d)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Charge Description: Corey Allen Collmann Also Known As Cory Allen Collmann, Corey Allan Collmann And Corey Allen Collmann

On or about August 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Corey Allen Collmann, did unlawfully possesses any amount of a synthetic cannabinoid.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 10, 201, at approximately 11:34 p.m., Officer Gangelhoff of Lake Crystal Police was on routine patrol in a fully marked squad vehicle and noticed an adult male on a motorcycle stop at a stop sign on County Road 20 North and Highway 60 in the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota. The adult male driver, later identified as Corey Allan Collmann, made direct eye contact with the Ganglehoff. Gangelhoff noted that Collmann was not wearing any eye protection. Collmann turned eastbound onto Highway 60, and Gangelhoff caught up to Collmann's vehicle. Collmann eventually turned off Highway 60 onto Lakeview Road and then drove into the driveway of a residence at the 900 block of Lakeview Court. Collmann then stepped off his motorcycle and approached Gangelhoff. Gangelhoff asked Collmann if he had any eye protection. Collmann proceeded to pull down a pair of glasses from the top of his head. Collmann admitted he did not live at the 900 block Lakeview Court residence but was visiting a friend who was expecting his arrival. However, Collmann was unable to provide a reason for visiting his "friend" at the 900 Lakeview Court address.

Officer Gangelhoff asked for the Defendant's Minnesota driver's license in response Collmann provided identification identified as "Real Person #1." Officer Gangelhoff noted the picture displayed on Real Person #1's driver's license did not look like the Collmann whatsoever. Collmann then admitted that the motorcycle was not his but belonged to an individual, 'Witness 1'. Collmann claimed Witness 1 gave Collmann permission to use the motorcycle. Eventually, Blue Earth County Deputy Cusey arrived on scene to assist Gangelhoff.

Gangelhoff conducted a routine check of the name provided by Collmann, which revealed a body only warrant for a drug-related warrant out of Kandiyohi County. After Gangelhoff told Collmann he would be placed under arrest for the outstanding warrant, Collmann then stated his real name was actually "False Name #2."

A routine check conducted on "False Name #2" revealed that the driving status of that individual was revoked. Gangelhoff also discovered that the 2015 black Honda CRV 300 motorcycle bearing Minnesota license plate driven by Collmann was entered as a stolen vehicle by the Mankato Department of Public Safety. The registered owner of the vehicle was Witness 1.

Gangelhoff noticed Collmann was carrying an Adidas drawstring bag. Later, discovered inside the bag was a T-Mobile cell phone, a ZTE Cricket cell phone, miscellaneous set of keys, wire cutter, Lucky 8 scratch off, Marlboro cigarettes, and a coin purse full of quarters. A small bag of green, leafy substance that NIC tested positive for synthetic cannabinoids was also located in the drawstring. The marijuana measured in at 5.9 grams on a non-certified scale at the Blue Earth County Justice Center in its packaging. A knife was also located on Collmann's person.

Deputy Cusey met and spoke with the owner of the residence at the 900 block of Lakeview Court, Witness 2. Witness 2 advised that he did not know who Collmann was and that nobody inside the residence was expecting anyone at the current time of night.

Collmann was subsequently transported to the Blue Earth County Justice Center. Collmann stated to the officer that he was previously arrested at the Blue Earth County Justice Center, and people at the jail would recognize him as "False Name #2."

Gangelhoff noted that the picture of False Name #2's driver's license photograph and recent booking photograph did not appear to be the physical descriptors of Collmann.

Collmann was later read his Miranda rights and consented to speaking with the officers.

The interview was conducted at 1:47 a.m. Collmann began speaking with the officer by claiming his name was indeed False Name #2 and provided a date of birth as well.

Collmann admitted to not wearing any eye protection on his face and stated he understood that was the reason why the officer pulled him over. Collmann stated he was coming from Eagle Lake; and prior to that, he was at a Lake Crystal car wash. Collmann stated the motorcycle did not belong to him but belonged to Witness 1, who Defendant asked permission from to use the motorcycle. Collmann later admitted that he did not get permission from Witness 1 to use the motorcycle. Collmann stated the motorcycle was sitting at his cousin's residence in Eagle Lake before he took the motorcycle without permission.

When Gangelhoff asked Collmann about the false name #1, Collmann stated he merely handed the wrong driver's license to the officer as he must have picked up False Name #1's license by mistake. Collmann also stated that the Adidas bag was somebody else's and the synthetic marijuana must be the other person's property. Collmann, however, could not remember how he met this other person nor did he know where this other person lived. Collmann further admitted to using methamphetamine approximately two days prior to the current arrest.

After completion of the interview, Collmann was released to jail staff. When jail staff was in the process of fingerprinting Collmann, jail staff recognized him, not as False Name #1 nor as False Name #2, but as Corey Allan Collmann.

On August 11, 2016, at approximately 5:00 p.m., Gangelhoff made contact with Witness 1. Witness 1 advised that he has never met Collmann and never gave permission to Collmann to use his motorcycle.

On August 11, 2016, at approximately 7:20 p.m., Gangelhoff spoke to the owner of the Lake Crystal car wash, Witness 3, who provided Gangelhoff with video of the previous evening.

Gangelhoff, via the video, noted that Collmann, when leaving the car wash and driving away, had sunglasses on top of his head and not over his eyes. Screen shot pictures of the video were taken to confirm.

Also, False Name #1 and False Name #2 are both names of real persons with real dates of birth.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
