The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Abuse No Contact Order - Violate No Contact Order - within 10 years of previous conviction

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(c)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/06/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16019932

Charge Description: David James Baker, Jr. Also Known As David James Baker

On or about July 6, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, David James Baker, Jr. did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation occurred during the time period between a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction and the end of the ten years following discharge from sentence for that offense.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Detective Tom Rother, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on July 6, 2016, at approximately 3:17 p.m., he was contacted by an employee of Blue Earth County Child Protection, who informed him that she was at a residence in the City of Mankato. The child protection employee informed Rother that she believed an individual, identified as David James Baker, Jr., was at the residence. The Blue Earth County Child Protection employee told Rother that she had seen a male, who matches the description of Baker, outside talking to an individual identified as Witness 1, who lived at the residence.

Rother notes that Baker is currently restrained by an active Domestic Assault No Contact Order which did not allow him to have contact with Witness 1.

Rother reports that he and Officer Lopez then went to the residence of Witness 1, who was the individual covered by the DANO order. At that point, officers had contact with Baker outside the residence.

Baker informed officers that he had just arrived at the residence and that Witness 1 was not at home. Rother then made contact with Witness 1's son, identified as Witness 2. Witness 2 informed Rother that Baker had been at the residence during the day. Witness 2 further stated that his mother, Witness 1, had just left.

Rother then contacted Witness 1 and told her to come home. A short time later, Witness 1 came home and immediately told Rother that she had no other options; so she asked Baker to babysit while she was at a job interview. Rother then, based on his investigation, arrested Baker for a violation of the DANCO order; and he was transported to jail.

Additionally, a review of Baker's criminal history reveals several pending domestic violence-related offenses.

Also, Baker was convicted in Blue Earth County District Court of an Order for Protection Violation as indicated in Blue Earth County Court File No. 07-CR-15-4482. Baker was sentenced for that offense on March 14, 2016.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
