The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 12/17/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15038666

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Kelly Adam Barry, did unlawfully receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Sean McClinton and others identified herein.

Officer Sean McClinton investigated an individual pawning a stolen item on December 17, 2015, at the Pawn America store, in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Officer McClinton identified the individual pawning the item as Kelly Adam Barry, the Defendant herein. Officer McClinton had earlier investigated a theft of items from a motor vehicle that occurred on December 7 or 8, 2015. Officer McClinton identified the victim in the theft of the items from the motor vehicle as V1. The items that were reported stolen was a Kenwood stereo and a GPS Garmin. V1's vehicle was damaged as a result of the theft from the vehicle. The value of the items stolen and the damage caused to V1's vehicle amounted to \$480.00.

Officer McClinton spoke with the Defendant regarding the incident. The Defendant stated he works for people on Craigslist called 'GIGS.' The Defendant claimed that he often trades items with people who don't have money to pay. The Defendant claimed that he did this with the GPS Garmin. The Defendant said that he didn't know the name of the person that he got the GPS from.

A computer check of the Defendant's criminal history indicates that he has a pending Third Degree Burglary - Felony offense pending in Blue Earth County. See Blue Earth County District Court File 07-CR-15-5283. In addition, the Defendant has a Theft offense pending in Blue Earth County found in Blue Earth County District Court File 07-CR-16-433. The Defendant has an open file in Nicollet County for Financial Transaction Card Fraud. See Nicollet County District Court File 52-CR-16-44.

Restitution is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
