COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: False Imprisonment-Intentional Restraint

Minnesota Statute: 609.255.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/16/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15032571

Charge Description: Ukeme Cornelius George

On or about October 16, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Ukeme Cornelius George did knowingly lacking lawful authority to do so, intentionally confined or restrained another person without that person's consent.

COUNT II

Charge: Criminal Sex Conduct-5th Degree-NonConsensual Sex Contact

Minnesota Statute: 609.3451.1(1), with reference to: 609.3451.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/16/2015

On or about October 16, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Ukeme Cornelius George did engage another in nonconsensual sexual contact.

COUNT III

Charge: Stalking - Intent to Injure

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000
Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Charge Description: Ukeme Cornelius George

On or about October 16, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Ukeme Cornelius George did, directly or indirectly, or through third parties, manifest a purpose or intent to injure the person, property or rights of another by the commission of an unlawful act.

COUNT IV

Charge: Emergency Telephone Calls/Communications - Interrupt, Interfere, Impede, Disrupt 911 Call

Minnesota Statute: 609.78.2(1)
Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000
Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/16/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15032571

Charge Description: Ukeme Cornelius George

On or about October 16, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Ukeme Cornelius George did interrupt, disrupt, impede, or otherwise interfere with an emergency call or intentionally prevented or hindered another from placing an emergency call.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 16, 2015, at approximately 11:04 p.m., Officer Katelyn Kaiser with the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to a residence in Mankato on a report of a sexual assault. W1 had called 911 and advised that a male by the name of "George," who would later be identified as Ukeme Cornelius George, would not let her leave his apartment. Prior to law enforcement's arrival, W1 advised that she was able to get out of the apartment but that the male was following her. W1 described the suspect as a black male wearing a long-sleeved, gray Old Navy shirt.

Upon arriving at the scene, Officer Kaiser noted that Officer Steve Hoppe was speaking with George. Officer Kaiser spoke with W1 about what had happened. W1 stated that she had met George the day prior. They exchanged phone numbers. W1 stated that she received a phone call from George today at approximately 9:00 a.m. and that George was inquiring about her plans for the day. W1 stated she had class and then work until 8:00 p.m. W1 stated that George picked her up after work and after she finished her homework and brought her back to his apartment in Stadium Heights. W1 stated that George was sitting by her and pulled her onto his lap. W1 advised that George bit her on the right breast. W1 stated that she told George that she wanted to leave, but George blocked the door and would not let her leave.

Officer Kaiser advised W1 she would like to conduct a formal statement with her, and W1 agreed to do so. The formal statement took place at the Public Safety Center. During the statement, W1 advised that the first time she met George was in September and that they were introduced by a mutual friend. W1 stated she had not seen George until the day prior when she saw him as she was walking down the steps of the library. W1 stated she and George exchanged phone numbers and that George stated he would call her. W1 stated she received a call from George at 9:21 a.m. the next morning, and he was asking what her plans for the day were. W1 stated she had class and work until 8:00 p.m. W1 stated when she was done working at 8:00 p.m., George called her and wanted her to come to his residence. W1 stated she finished her homework at approximately 9:00 p.m. and that at 9:10 p.m., George called her, stating he was coming to pick her up.

Shortly after this phone call, George had come into the dormitory where W1 was waiting for him. W1 and George got into a vehicle that was driven by one of George's friends. The vehicle took them to George's residence on Heron Drive. W1 stated that once inside George's residence, they were the only two there. W1 sat down in a black chair that had armrests, and she and George made small talk. W1 told George that she had not eaten since around noon, and George made her a sandwich and some chicken. W1 stated that throughout this time, George kept offering her wine and trying to get her to drink. W1 stated she continually refused, telling George she does not drink. George told W1 that he does not do anything for females, but he would do anything for her. W1 stated that while George was making her food, he would go back and forth from the kitchen, sitting on the arm of the chair. W1 advised that when George was sitting on the arm of the chair, he was putting his arm around her on her shoulder. W1 stated that when George would do this, she would tell him to move but that George did not move and called her Baby Angel.

W1 stated that George kept trying to hold her hand; and she would move her arm away, not wanting him to hold her hand. W1 stated that George then got up to get the chicken he was making and then came back and sat on the armrest again before sliding down into the seat next to W1. W1 stated that George then picked her up like a "baby," putting his hand under her feet and then sliding her onto his lap. W1 told him to put her down; and George replied, "I would rather have my baby angel on my lap." W1 told him she had to eat the food he made her; and George replied, "I would rather have my angel eat on my lap."

W1 again told George to put her down. George then bit W1 on her right breast over her clothes. W1 stated she was still wearing a coat at the time that George bit her. After George bit W1, she told him she needed

to leave. W1 stated she tried to stand up, and George grabbed her by her right arm with his hand and pulled her back onto his lap. W1 again stood up and told George she needed to leave. George then stood up and blocked the door to keep W1 from leaving. W1 stated that George would not let her leave and would move to block the door whenever she moved. W1 stated that George kept telling her he wanted her to stay and finish the food he had made her. W1 stated, at one point, George pushed her on the shoulder and she thought he was going to push her back into the chair.

W1 advised that she then pulled out her phone to call 911. When she did this, George attempted to grab the phone but W1 pulled it back. W1 stated that George continued to try to get the phone while she was speaking with dispatch. W1 advised that while she was on the phone with dispatch, George finally let her out of the apartment, stating, "Fine, you want to leave. You can leave." W1 left the apartment, and George followed her. W1 stated that George looked at her surprised, saying, "You are the first girl ever to call the cops on me."

W1 stated she was going to walk home, then she saw a bus. W1 stated she got on the bus, and George followed her to the bus and stood outside of the bus staring at her. W1 stated she was at George's house for approximately an hour and a half and that during that time, she saw George drink four beers and an unknown amount of wine. W1 stated that when George would not let her leave, she was afraid he was going to rape her. Officer Kaiser noted that W1 was visibly upset and emotional regarding what had happened.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
