**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/19/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16021441

Charge Description: Diallo Sekou Odia Brown Also Known As Diallo Sekou Odia Coleman Brown, Ajamu Itim Brown Brown, Diallo Seakovodia Brown Brown, Diallo Seakouod Brown Brown, Dion Smith, Diallo Sekouodia, Diallo Seakouodia, Diallo Sckouodia And Diallo Sekou-Odia Brown

On or about July 19, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Diallo Sekou Odia Brown did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Introduce Contraband-Drug/Liquor into Jail/Lockup/Prison**

Minnesota Statute: 641.165.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

On or about July 19, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Diallo Sekou Odia Brown did introduce or in any manner cause the introduction of contraband into any jail, lock-up, or correctional facility, without the consent of the person in charge, or is found in possession of contraband while within the facility or upon the grounds thereof.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Sean McClinton, licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota, currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on July 19, 2016, at approximately 2:34 p.m., he was running stationary radar westbound on Madison Avenue and North 7th Street, in the City of Mankato, when he observed a 2010 Dodge Charger bearing Minnesota license plate 830 BLB, on North 7th Street.

McClinton reports he is familiar with the vehicle and has cited the driver of the vehicle several times for Driving After Revocation. Additionally, McClinton knew that the driver did not have a valid driver's license and was currently revoked. McClinton notes the revoked driver was Diallo Sekou Odia Brown.

McClinton reports that while driving past McClinton, Brown indicated that he knew he was caught and pointed to his residence which was about a block away. McClinton took that to mean that Brown was going to park the vehicle at his residence.

McClinton then followed the vehicle as it pulled into a driveway on North 6th Street.

McClinton then activated his lights and stopped the vehicle. Brown then advised McClinton that he knew that he should not be driving.

McClinton notes that while speaking with Brown he could smell the overwhelming smell of marijuana. Additionally, McClinton asked if there was any marijuana in the car; and Brown advised that there wasn't. McClinton then asked Brown why it smelled so bad. Brown advised he had gotten a friend a 'dime bag' and the smell was on his hands. However, McClinton noted that the smell was not dissipating and continued to be strong.

McClinton then had Brown exit the vehicle to perform a search for marijuana. During the search McClinton located in the top compartment of the center console a plastic baggy with four pink pills in it. McClinton noted they appeared to be prescription pills. McClinton then asked Brown what the pills were, and Brown advised they were Adderall. Brown further stated that a friend left them in the vehicle.

McClinton notes that he later had an opportunity to identify the pills found in the vehicle and noted that the pills, based on their markings, were Oxycodone which is a scheduled II controlled substance.

Brown was then transported to the Blue Earth County Jail. While at the Blue Earth County Jail, Brown was searched for contraband by jail staff. During that search, custody officers located in Brown's right sock two baggies which both contained a green leafy substance that had the strong smell of marijuana. McClinton further notes those substances NIK-tested positive for marijuana.

McClinton reports that one of the baggies contained 1 gram of marijuana and the other baggie contained 6 grams of marijuana.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
