The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/13/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16031094

Charge Description: Farhan All Ahmed

On or about October 13, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Farhan All Ahmed, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

COUNT II

Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Offensive/Abusive/Noisy/Obscene

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/13/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16031094

Charge Description: Farhan All Ahmed

On or about October 13, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Farhan All Ahmed did, in a public or private place, knowingly, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene,

abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Kevin Waterstreet, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota, currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on October 13, 2016, at approximately 8:47 a.m., he was dispatched to a disturbance complaint at the Days Inn located at 1285 Range Street in the City of Mankato. Dispatch informed him that there was a male inside the lobby causing problems. Dispatch further informed Waterstreet that they could hear yelling in the background but were unable to make out what was being said.

Waterstreet reports he arrived on scene to make contact with an individual inside the lobby, later identified as Farhan Ahmed. Waterstreet notes that Ahmed displayed signs of agitation, including pacing, talking loudly, and being slightly out of breath. At that time, Waterstreet asked Ahmed to walk outside of the lobby so he and Ahmed could speak outside.

Once outside, Waterstreet had Ahmed sit on a bench and asked him what happened. Ahmed then told Waterstreet that he and his wife had gotten into a fight and he left their home to stay at the hotel until things cooled down. Ahmed stated he had his wife's debit card and the hotel would not let him check in because the name on the card did not match his identification. Ahmed admitted to becoming upset with the situation and raising his voice. Ahmed reported that while upset, he stated that the hotel manager, identified as Victim 1, called him a 'nigger.' At that point, Ahmed reports he lost his cool and began yelling and pacing in and out of the hotel until officers arrived.

Waterstreet further noted while talking to Ahmed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. Ahmed also displayed other indicia of alcohol impairment, including bloodshot and glossy eyes.

Waterstreet reports that other officers eventually arrived and stayed with Ahmed. Waterstreet then went into the hotel and spoke with the manager, Witness 1. Witness 1 explained the incident to Waterstreet but was having trouble because of a language barrier between Witness 1 and Waterstreet. Witness 1 then stated he had a video of the incident and asked Waterstreet to watch the video.

Waterstreet then observed the video and noted that Ahmed entered the hotel and when Ahmed is told he cannot use his wife's card to pay for the hotel, he becomes very upset. Waterstreet then observes Ahmed stating 'I'll beat you up' to the front-desk employee and observes Witness 1 come from a back room and tell Ahmed to 'get out of here.' Waterstreet then observes Ahmed yelling 'Talk to me, I'll fuck you up' at Witness 1 and charges the doorway leading to Witness 1's location behind the front desk in an aggressive manner. Ahmed then, while still in the doorway, states, 'Bitch, I'll fuck you and him up,' to both Witness 1 and the front-desk employee. Shortly thereafter, Waterstreet observes Ahmed tell Witness 1, 'If you touch me, I'll break your neck,' and immediately follows by saying 'I'll kill you.'

Witness 1 further reported to Waterstreet that he felt threatened by Ahmed's actions and felt it necessary to grab a mop to potentially defend himself. Waterstreet notes that at no time during the altercation did Witness 1 call Ahmed a 'nigger.'

Ahmed was then placed under arrest and transported to the Blue Earth County Justice Center. While at the jail, Ahmed submitted to a preliminary breath test which indicated an alcohol level of .16.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
