COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-By Swindle

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(4)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/04/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16016501

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Antown Shatrail Hibbler, did by swindling, whether by artifice, trick, device, or any other means, obtains property or services from another person.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Mohamed Mohamed and others identified herein.

On June 4, 2016, at approximately 2:59 p.m., Officer Mohamed of Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to Wal-Mart at 1881 Madison Avenue in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, regarding a theft.

At approximately 2:30 p.m., a male, later identified as Antwon Shatrail Hibbler, the Defendant herein, entered the Wal-Mart pushing an empty shopping cart. The Defendant pushed his empty cart to the automotive aisles and obtained car speakers and subwoofers from the shelving units and placed them into the shopping cart. The Defendant pushed the shopping cart towards the exit where the Defendant initially attempted to walk out with the merchandise before being deterred by Wal-Mart employees. The Defendant told the Wal-Mart employee that he entered the store with the merchandise to return it, but forgot the receipt in his vehicle. Wal-Mart employees escorted the Defendant to the service desk where the Defendant began returning the merchandise from his shopping cart. During his return to the service desk, Witness 1, a loss prevention employee for Wal-Mart, was able to identify the Defendant by way of driver's license as Antown Shatrail Hibbler. It should be noted that Witness 1 was able to confirm the above-mentioned via video surveillance. The Defendant was given a gift card for the merchandise in the cart, specifically the subwoofers and speakers, totaling \$335.78. The Wal-Mart gift card number was recorded and given to the Officer Mohamed of Mankato Police. After obtaining his gift card, the Defendant exited the store and loss prevention was unable to locate the Defendant at that time.

Later that evening, on June 4, 2016, at approximately 8:47 p.m., Wal-Mart loss prevention advised Officer Mohamed that the gift card issued to the Defendant was used in the store by a female, later identified as Witness 2. Loss prevention confirmed that the gift card provided to the Defendant was the same gift card used on June 4, 2016 at approximately 8:47 p.m. by Witness 2. Loss prevention also informed Officer Mohamed that loss prevention recognized the Defendant from a previous theft case. Defendant was subsequently cited for shoplifting and was again trespassed from Wal-Mart. After further investigation, Officer Mohamed contacted Witness 2 who agreed to answer Officer Mohamed's questions. Witness 2 stated that a gift card was given to Witness 2 directly by the Defendant in order to purchase a Playstation video game system. Witness 2 was unaware of how the Defendant obtained the gift card.

It should be noted that the Defendant has an alias of Antwon Shawntil Hibbler. The Defendant was convicted of misdemeanor theft in 2015 in Blue Earth County Court File No. 07-CR-15-3429 and subsequently trespassed from the Walmart location.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
