On or about January 29, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Misha Milad Sadaka did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On January 29, 2016, Officer Tim Mohr of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was contacted by Commander McDermott regarding a physical child abuse investigation. Officer Mohr was advised that two children, identified as Child1 and Child2, had been dropped off at their daycare that morning with unexplained bruises. The mother, who was identified as Misha Milad Sadaka, DOB 7-7-89, had dropped them off without advising the daycare provider as to how the children received the injuries to their face and neck regions.

Officer Mohr was advised that Child1 and Child2 came into the daycare upset and crying but would not tell the daycare provider why. The daycare provider was later told by Child1 that his mom slapped him and pushed him against the wall. Child1 also stated that Sadaka told him that he could not tell the daycare provider what happened.

Officer Mohr made contact with Ronda Morehead from Blue Earth County Human Services Child Protection. Morehead sent Officer Mohr a photo of the injury to Child1. Officer Mohr observed Child1 had a bruise along the right side of his face by his cheek and neck. He also observed red marks on Child1. Officer Mohr and Morehead drove to the daycare to speak to Child1 and Child2.

Upon arriving at the location in Mankato, Blue Earth County, Officer Mohr made contact with the daycare provider. On making contact with the daycare provider, Child1 immediately began telling Morehead and Officer Mohr about Sadaka slapping him, pulling his ear, pulling his hair, and pushing him into the wall. Officer Mohr and Morehead then spoke to the children in a private area in the basement of the daycare.

Child1 and Child2 disclosed that Sadaka got upset with them and gave them their injuries. They stated that she hurt them and slapped them. Child1 stated the line on his face was from his brother but then stated the marks were from Sadaka. Officer Mohr was able to determine that a set of keys had been displaced and Sadaka got upset at the children and hit them. Child2 stated that Sadaka gave Child1 his marks. Morehead was able to determine that this occurred in their apartment in Mankato, Blue Earth County.

After conducting the interview with the children, Officer Mohr photographed them and observed that Child1 had red marks on his ear and there was a spot that was consistent with being pulled or pinched. Child2 had red marks on the right side of his cheek that appeared to be from being hit.

Officer Mohr and Morehead then set up a meeting with Sadaka at the Blue Earth County Government Center. Sadaka stated that her kids hid her keys and she only had 15 minutes to get to work. She admitted being emotional lately and stressed out and that she took it out on the kids. Sadaka stated she screamed at them and slapped Child1 across the face, twice. At that time, Sadaka was getting emotional and was visibly upset and crying. Sadaka advised Morehead that she used an open hand when hitting Child1. She stated that she noticed Child1 was a little red when Morehead asked if she noticed if she had left a mark on him. Sadaka stated she was not sure what side of the face the mark was on because she was in a hurry to get to work. She stated she hasn't slept in weeks because her littlest one has been teething and she is raising all three of her kids without getting help from anyone.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
