The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 4th Degree - Sale Marijuana in School/Park/Pub Housing Zone/Drug Treatment

Minnesota Statute: 152.024.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 15 years and/or \$100,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/08/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000726

Charge Description: Jawaun Tyrell Taylor Also Known As Jawaun Tyrell Taylor

On or about January 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jawaun Tyrell Taylor did unlawfully sell any amount of marijuana or Tetrahydrocannabinols, in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility, except a small amount for no remuneration.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On January 8, 2016, Officer Matt Vitale with the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the Cherry Ridge Apartments located at 101 Glenwood Avenue in the City of Mankato in reference to information that a suspect in an armed robbery from the day before may be located at that residence.

The suspect was identified as Jawaun Taylor; he had a temporary felon wanted for aggravated robbery designation. Officer Vitale, along with Officer Will Hullpeter (also of the Mankato Department of Public Safety) waited outside the apartment for approximately 15 minutes, during which period of time they could hear different male voices. One of the voices could be heard on the phone telling another party to meet him at the back door in 2 minutes. A few minutes later, Taylor walked out of the apartment and Officer Vitale was able to immediately identify him from his Blue Earth County jail photo and from prior investigations. When asked, he responded that his name was Taylor. Taylor was immediately placed into handcuffs because of his suspected involvement with the aggravated robbery and was transported to the Public Safety Center for a follow-up interview.

At approximately 8:39 p.m., Officer Vitale completed a recorded interview with Taylor. Taylor was read his Miranda Rights and agreed to speak with Officer Vitale. Taylor admitted that he had approximately a half ounce of marijuana in his pocket and that he was going to give his cousin, Adult1, some of the marijuana, approximately 2 blunts' worth, when he met up with him. Taylor also admitted that approximately 1 to 1 1/2 ounces of marijuana were taken the previous day's robbery and he had been discussing a deal for \$300 for that marijuana. Taylor was interviewed regarding the aggravated robbery and provided limited information other than that it was a 'drug deal gone bad.'

Taylor's person was searched, and law enforcement recovered a clear plastic bag containing approximately 18 grams of marijuana, which later field-tested positive for marijuana, a digital scale, and two black cellphones. It should be noted that the Cherry Ridge Apartments are located in a public housing zone.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
