The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Kidnapping-To Facilitate Felony or Flight

Minnesota Statute: 609.25.1(2), with reference to: 609.25.2(1)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$35,000

Offense Level: Felony

On or about January 16, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jalen Tyrice Dorsey did confine or remove from one place to another, any person without the person's consent, or if the person is under the age of 16 years, without the consent of the person's parents or other legal custodian, and did so to facilitate commission of any felony or flight thereafter

On or about January 16, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jalen Tyrice Dorsey did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death and has two or more qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within ten years following discharge from sentence or disposition for that offense.

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

On or about January 16, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jalen Tyrice Dorsey, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01, Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within ten years following discharge from sentence or disposition for that offense.

COUNT V

Charge: Stalking - Pattern of Stalking Conduct

Minnesota Statute: 609.749.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years and/or \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

On or about January 16, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jalen Tyrice Dorsey did engage in a pattern of stalking conduct with respect to a single victim or one or more members of a single household, which the actor knows or has reason to know, would cause the victim under the circumstances, to feel terrorized or to fear bodily harm and which does cause this reaction on the part of the victim.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On January 16, 2016 at approximately 4:46 AM, Officer Dan Grassman with the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched, along with other officers from the department, to an address in Mankato to check on the welfare of a female party who would later be identified as V1. V1, it was reported, could be heard yelling and crying for the prior 10 to 15 minutes. While in route to location dispatch advised that V1 was on the phone reporting a physical domestic assault that had occurred between herself and the suspect Jalen Tyrice Dorsey. V1 was asking for help, stating that her front tooth had been knocked out and that there was blood all over the apartment. V1 advised that Dorsey had left the apartment.

Officer Grassman arrived a few minutes after the incident was reported and entered the apartment complex. As Officer Grassman approached the apartment door, he could hear V1 yelling, screaming and crying from inside. Officer Grassman knocked on the door and V1 answered. Officer Grassman observed that V1 was crying and doubled over, holding her stomach. V1's shirt and pants were covered in fresh blood and there was blood spatter about the front entryway and hallway. V1 appeared disheveled, distraught, emotional, physically hurt and upset.

V1 advised that Dorsey had run out the back patio door. Officer Grassman entered the apartment and observed the patio door was halfway open. Gold Cross arrived on the scene and observed V1. V1's visible injuries included a broken front tooth, a slightly swollen right eye and a bump/knot on the front right side of her forehead.

V1 advised that she had let Dorsey into the apartment and that he had started to physically assault her by hitting her with his fists and an unknown object. Due to V1's highly emotional state it was determined that V1 would be brought to the Public Safety Center for a formal interview.

Once at the Public Safety Center V1 stated that she had been sleeping when someone knocked on the door. V1 asked who it was and Dorsey identified himself. V1 opened the door and went back to the bedroom. Dorsey followed her and started yelling at her. V1 told Dorsey to calm down and that they would talk about in the morning. Dorsey became angry and started hitting V1; she tried to cover herself up with a blanket. While being hit about the body, V1 was hit in the face and her front tooth was broken. V1 stated she was screaming while this was going on and asked Dorsey to just kill her if that's what he wanted to do. After Dorsey stopped hitting V1, she tried to escape the apartment out the patio door, leaving in a tank top, sweatpants and no shoes. Dorsey followed V1 outside, grabbed her as she was screaming and placed his hand over her mouth. Dorsey pulled V1 back into the apartment and locked the patio door. Dorsey then grabbed V1 by her hair and pulled her back into the bedroom where he started hitting her again with his hands.

V1 stated she grabbed her phone and tried to call 911. Dorsey then yelled at V1 'bitch you ain't going anywhere' and 'I'll give you a reason to call the police' and 'I'm going to jail for a reason.' Dorsey then heard sirens and ran out the back door. V1 stated she believed she was hit over 15 times about the head and body. V1 reported that she has known Dorsey for about 3 to 4 months and that they were in a romantic relationship.

A check of Dorsey's criminal history reveals two qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions: the first, a conviction for Criminal Sexual Conduct in the Fourth Degree from August of 2012 can be found in Blue Earth County file 07-CR-12-2949; the second, a conviction for Assault in the Fifth Degree from June of 2012 can be found in Blue Earth County file 07-CR-12-1996.

It should also be noted that Dorsey has an open file (07-CR-15-5261) in which he is charged with Domestic

Assault as a felony and the victim is the same as the one in this case.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
