COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16013791

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Sara Elizabeth Olson, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Katelyn Marie Kaiser and others identified herein.

On May 11, 2016, at approximately 2:53 p.m., Victim 1 came to the Public Safety Center, in the City of Mankato, to file a domestic violence report. Victim 1 stated he was a victim of domestic assault that occurred on March 13, 2016 at the approximate location of Victim 1's residence, specifically, the 400 block of Lilly Street, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota.

Victim 1 advised that on March 13, 2016, at approximately 8:30 p.m., Sara Elizabeth Olson, the Defendant herein, drove to Victim 1's house to discuss issues regarding the Defendant's pregnancy. Victim 1 entered into the Defendant's vehicle and both Defendant and Victim 1 drove around the city of Mankato, discussing the pregnancy. At the time of discussion the Defendant was approximately eight months pregnant. While driving, the Defendant gave Victim 1 a list of things he had to do if he did not want to pay child support. At some point during the drive the Defendant parked her vehicle in front of Victim 1's residence. Victim 1 stated to the Defendant that he just wanted to be left alone. At which point, the Defendant became very upset.

The Defendant then ripped off her seatbelt and with a closed fist struck Victim 1 in the shoulder, face, and lip. The strike to Victim 1's lip caused a cut and slight swelling. Victim 1 attempted to take his seatbelt off and exit the vehicle. However, before Victim 1 was able to do so, the Defendant accelerated her vehicle toward the T-intersection of a road which had a grove of trees. As the Defendant accelerated her vehicle the Defendant stated, 'This ends tonight.' While approaching the T-intersection, the Defendant slammed on her brakes. Once the car came to a stop, Victim 1 turned in an attempt to exit the vehicle, and the Defendant struck Victim 1 in the upper back. Eventually, Victim 1 was able to exit the vehicle, and Victim 1 ran to his residence.

It should be noted that Victim 1 filed and was granted a Restraining Order against the Defendant and in turn the Defendant filed a Harassment Restraining Order against Victim 1.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
