COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/13/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16020710

Charge Description: Zachary Thomas Young

On or about July 13, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Zachary Thomas Young did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Agent Sam McGinnis, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota currently assigned to the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force, reports that on July 13, 2016, in the City of Mankato, officers learned of illegal controlled substance-related activity occurring at a residence at 306 Louva Lane in the City of Mankato.

Officers learned that an individual who resides there, identified as Zachary Thomas Young, was reportedly involved in the use and sale of methamphetamine. Agents were able to secure a search warrant for the residence, and that search warrant was executed on July 13, 2016.

Agents then executed the search warrant at approximately 7:15 p.m. at which time Agent Ruch knocked on the door of the residence and announced several times. Eventually, Young opened the door; and Agent Ruch secured Young without incident.

McGinnis reports a search of the residence resulted in the discovery of numerous used methamphetamine pipes in Zachary Young's bedroom, which field tested positive for methamphetamine.

Agents also discovered numerous gem-style plastic baggies that McGinnis notes, based on his training and experience, are used by individuals engaged in the illegal use of controlled substances.

Agents also found a digital scale, a black BB gun, and 1.1 grams of a crystalized substance located in a magnetic key holder underneath Young's desk in his bedroom. That substance field tested positive for methamphetamine.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
