The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possession of Burglary or Theft Tools

Minnesota Statute: 609.59

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/03/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15038054

Charge Description: Travis John Olson Also Known As Chad Allen Olson, Travis J Olson And Travis Olson

On or about December 3, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Travis John Olson did have in his/her possession any device, explosive, or other instrumentality with intent to use or permit the use of the same to commit burglary or theft.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On December 3, 2015 at approximately 3:14 a.m., Officer William Hullopeter of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to Xcel Energy at 210 Lime Street in Mankato, Blue Earth County on the report of a possible theft in progress. Dispatch reported that a motion camera and sensor were activated on the property. An employee had remotely viewed the camera footage and saw a male on the video. The complainant described him as a white male wearing a hoodie and baggy jeans.

Upon arriving at the scene, officers set up a perimeter around the property. Officer Hullopeter stood next to the adjacent building, Ramy Turf Products. He observed the chain link fence with barbed wire on top that went around the building. While he was standing there, he observed a white male, wearing a green hoodie and blue jeans, later identified as Travis John Olson, DOB 3-19-85, climb the fence next to the Ramy Turf Products building approximately 15 feet from where he was standing. Officer Hullopeter observed that when Olson reached the top of the fence, he jumped down onto the ground. At that time, Officer Hullopeter pointed his Taser at Olson and gave him a loud verbal command to get on the ground.

After handcuffing Olson, Officer Hullopeter located a small bolt cutter in Olson's back pocket. He also located three small flashlights in Olson's front pockets. Officer Hullopeter observed that he was wearing five t-shirts or long sleeved shirts under his hooded sweatshirt and he was wearing thermal leggings under his blue jeans. Olson claimed he didn't know what was going on and stated he was just coming from the Holiday gas station.

Other officers located a backpack and extension cords located near a hole in the fence on the east side of the property. Officer Reinbold located a vehicle parked on North Broad Street, to the east of the hole in the fence. He noted that the vehicle did not have frost on it like other cars parked on the street. An officer also located a wallet next to the vehicle, lying on the ground, that belonged to Olson.

Olson was read his Miranda warning and agreed to speak to the officers. He stated he was coming from the Holiday gas station and that he jumped the fence because it was a short cut. He stated he was going to a girl's house but he would not say where because it was not important. He stated he was with a bunch of people.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
