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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm**

On or about August 27, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Casey Alan Vogel did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another.

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting**

On or about August 27, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Casey Alan Vogel did, in a public or private place, knowingly, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 27, 2016 at approximately 11:39 PM Officer Jensen responded to a report of a disturbance in the 100 block Breckenridge Path in Eagle Lake, Blue Earth County. At that address he spoke with witness 1, who reported that Casey Alan Vogel, the defendant, had entered her residence uninvited throwing items around and would not leave when she told him to. Officer Jensen also spoke with the victim, who reported he had been assaulted by the defendant. The victim reported that the defendant attempted to punch him so the victim tackled the defendant to try to subdue him. The defendant then punched the victim on the left cheek. Officer Jensen examined the victim's face and observed injuries on the inside of his cheek. Officer Jensen called the defendant by telephone. The defendant admitted he had been at witness ones house and that he had not been invited over. The defendant admitted that he did not leave when he was asked to reported he didn't leave because he didn't have his shoes. He further admitted that he and the victim wrestled but denied any punches were thrown.
