The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/08/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16027168

Charge Description: Lisa Ann Fontaine

On or about September 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Lisa Ann Fontaine, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/08/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16027168

Charge Description: Lisa Ann Fontaine

On or about September 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Lisa Ann Fontaine did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 8, 2016 at approximately 3:04 PM officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence northeast of downtown Mankato on a report of a disturbance. Officers Wayne Terry, Jeff Fischbach and Sergeant Adam Gray responded.

As Sergeant Gray was approaching the residence he noted that V1 was holding down the suspect who would later be identified as Lisa Ann Fontaine. Sergeant Gray noted that V1 had injuries to his head and facial area as well as his chest.

Officer Terry spoke with V1. V1 reported that he is the landlord for the residence in which he and Fontaine reside. V1 stated that Fontaine came downstairs to his apartment and was upset about an eviction proceeding. V1 stated that Fontaine was yelling at him and threatening legal action. V1 stated that he turned to walk away and stepped outside of his residence to throw garbage in a garbage can while Fontaine continued yelling at him.

V1 stated that he turned his back to walk into the residence and Fontaine pushed him from behind forcing him up against the side of the residence. V1 stated that Fontaine then grabbed him from behind and forced him down on top of a garbage can. Officer Terry found Fontaine's glasses in the open garbage can. V1 stated that Fontaine was biting, scratching and repeatedly punching him about the head and body. V1 stated he was attempting to push her back but that Fontaine took him to the ground and continued to assault him. V1 stated that he was able to get Fontaine off of him and get back to his feet but that Fontaine continued to fight him and took him to the ground a second time. V1 stated that he was able to get on top of Fontaine and hold her down while yelling for someone to call the police. V1 stated that Fontaine was threatening him stating 'I'm going to kill you!' And 'you are dead!'

Sergeant Gray spoke with Fontaine. Fontaine stated she went to V1's apartment to speak with him about a rental inspection. Fontaine stated she knocked on V1's apartment door and spoke with him. Fontaine claimed that V1 was the aggressor, however she admitted that she grabbed V1 by the arms and neck and that she bit him and could have possibly scratched him.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
