The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 4th Degree - Possess - Phencyclidine/Hallucinogen 10 or More Doses

Minnesota Statute: 152.024.2(1), with reference to: 152.024.3

Maximum Sentence: 15 years and/or \$100,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/21/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028534

Charge Description: Adam Michael Wencil

On or about September 21, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Adam Michael Wencil did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing phencyclidine or hallucinogen, it is packaged in dosage units, and equals ten or more dosage units.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 21, 2016, Officer Stephanie Wilkins, with the Mankato Department of Public Safety, contacted Agent Matthew Huettl, with the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force, regarding a narcotics investigation. Officer Wilkins advised she was requested by Blue Earth County Probation to accompany them to Residence1 for a client check on Adam Michael Wencil. On arrival, Officer Wilkins and Agent Crocker made contact with Wencil. Upon searching Wencil's room they located paper blotter squares which they believed to be laced with acid.

Upon speaking with Agent Crocker, Agent Crocker advised that she had received a police report from a Mankato Police Officer dated September 18, 2016, in which it was reported that Wencil had attempted to sell LSD to a female party at Business 1. Officer Wilkins advised that once the paper blotter squares were located inside the apartment, the search was stopped and the scene was secured until a search warrant was obtained.

Agent Huettl drafted, applied, and was granted a lawful search for the residence. Agent Huettl and Agent Chad Ruch, also with the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force, arrived at Residence1 and executed the warrant. Upon entering the apartment and the bedroom that was advised to be Wencil's bedroom, agents observed a silver metal case on a chair containing 24 blotter squares and a cellphone.

Agents met with Wencil at the Blue Earth County Jail interview room and advised him of his rights. After reading Miranda, Wencil admitted to having the cigarette holder and stated he was aware of the blotter paper that was in the container. Wencil, at that time, advised that the substance on the paper was an unscheduled substance in the United States but did not provide any further information.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
