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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Predatory Offender-Knowingly Violates Registration Req. or Intentionally Provides False Information**

Minnesota Statute: 243.166.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16015985

Charge Description: Johnathan James Wilson Matney

On or about May 30, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Johnathan James Wilson Matney did, as a person required to register under section 243.166, knowingly violated any of its provisions or intentionally provided false information to a corrections agent, law enforcement authority, or the bureau.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16015985

Charge Description: Johnathan James Wilson Matney

On or about May 30, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Johnathan James Wilson Matney did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 30, 2016, at approximately 10:15 p.m., Officer Gagnon and Officer Price of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were in the area of the 600 block of North Fourth Street in Mankato, Blue Earth County, when Officer Price heard a male who was later identified as Johnathan James Matney, D.O.B. 12-16-1985, yelling out loud, "Fuck you, motherfucker." Officer Price observed that Matney was with a female party, who was later identified as Joline Christine Nordlee, D.O.B. 12-3-1987; and they were walking towards Officer Price. Officer Price did not know if they needed assistance at that time, so he approached them to see what was going on.

Officer Price spoke to Nordlee and Matney, and Nordlee stated "everything was fine" and they were just conversing. Officer Price expressed his concern because he heard Matney yelling. Officer Gagnon observed that Matney had been staggering when he was walking, had difficulty standing without swaying, and had slurred speech. Officer Gagnon also observed that Matney had a difficult time comprehending simply instructions. Officer Price attempted to identify Matney several times but had difficulty understanding him. Officer Price observed that Matney appeared nervous and that he was swaying and slurring his words. Officer Price also observed Matney looking around, which Officer Price knew from his training and experience was an indication that Matney was looking for a route to escape with the least resistance. Based on that, Officer Price grabbed onto Matney's right arm and escorted him to his squad car.

While Matney was being escorted to the squad car, Matney reached into his pocket, even after being told not to. Matney was then searched, and two pills were located in his possession. Matney at first lied, stating the pills were not his. He then later admitted that he had three pills. One of the pills located in Matney's pocket was Alprazolam, which is a Schedule IV narcotic. The other pill Matney possessed was a prescription pill.

Officer Price spoke to Nordlee about the incident. Nordlee stated she did not have any pills in her possession. Officer Price then asked Nordlee if he could check her. Nordlee then pulled out an Ibuprofen bottle and handed it to Officer Price. Nordlee stated she had a prescription for the pills inside the bottle. It was later learned that the bottle contained Alprazolam, a Schedule IV narcotic. Officer Price asked if Nordlee wanted to go to her residence to get the prescription. Nordlee stated she could not go there because that is "where my niece and nephew go." Officers then asked where Nordlee got the prescription pills, and she stated Walgreen's. Officers asked if she wanted to go to Walgreen's to verify that information. Nordlee then threw her arms in the air and said, "They were given to me." Nordlee informed Officer Gagnon that a friend had recently given her the pills that were inside the Ibuprofen bottle. Nordlee admitted to Officer Gagnon that she is the one that gave Matney the pills he had in his possession.

A record check revealed that Matney is required to register as a predatory offender in Oregon, South Dakota, and Nevada. Officers checked the predatory offender registration website for Minnesota and learned that Matney has not registered in the State of Minnesota. A record check also revealed that Matney had contact with Minnesota law enforcement in March 2016. Matney has still not registered in the State of Minnesota as required.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
