COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Trespass-Return to Property Within One Year

Minnesota Statute: 609.605.1(b)(8)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/16/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16011142

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Blake Patrick Fiereck, did return to the property of another within one year after being told to leave the property and not to return, if the actor is without claim of right to the property or consent of one with authority to consent.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Jeff Fischbach and others identified herein.

On April 16, 2016, at approximately 7:55 p.m., Officer Fischbach responded to a report of an individual trespassing at a residence in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Law enforcement responded to that location and observed a male being chased. The male being chased was identified as Blake Patrick Fiereck, the Defendant herein. Officer Fischbach identified the complainant as Complainant 1. Complainant 1 indicated that the Defendant had been trespassed from the location. Complainant 1 reported that the Defendant had returned to the location. According to Complainant 1, the Defendant said that he came back in order to find out where Complainant 1 lived. Complainant 1 and other security personnel present took the statement by the Defendant as a threat. Complainant 1 stated that he felt threatened by the Defendant's statement. While Officer Fischbach was dealing with the Defendant, the Defendant stated, "I'm getting pretty pissed, and I'll find out where you live." The statement was directed towards Complainant 1.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
