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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-4th Deg-Peace Officer-Physically Assaults-G**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/25/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15033645

Charge Description: Callie Maureen Daly

On or about October 25, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Callie Maureen Daly did, physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer**

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

On or about October 25, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Callie Maureen Daly did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

**COUNT III**

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Offensive/Abusive/Noisy/Obscene**

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/25/2015

Charge Description: Callie Maureen Daly

On or about October 25, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Callie Maureen Daly did, in a public or private place, knowingly, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Dan Best, a licensed police officer in the State of Minnesota currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on October 25, 2015 at approximately 12:59 a.m., he responded to the downtown Mankato area due to other officers' request to transport an individual who was being detained due to her behavior and apparent high level of intoxication. Officer Best later learned that that individual was identified as Callie Maureen Daly.

Best reports upon his arrival he noticed that Daly was being belligerent towards Officer Kranz and Officer Kruger. Best placed Daly in the back seat of his squad un-handcuffed and spoke briefly with Officer Kruger about taking her to Detox. While he was attempting to speak with Officer Kruger, Daly began punching and striking the back window of Best's squad car. Officer Best did not want Daly to injure herself or damage the car, so he had Daly step out of the back seat, handcuffed her, and placed her back into the squad. Best reports Daly was reluctant to get into the squad and began to argue but was eventually placed into the back seat.

Daly was transported to the Public Safety Center to await transportation to Detox. Best reports while at the Public Safety Center, Daly's behavior began to escalate to the point where she urinated on herself and began kicking the metal holding room door with her bare feet. Best was concerned that she would injure her feet or perhaps even break her toes, so he and Officer Gagnon placed leg restraints on Daly and laid her on her stomach.

Best reports Daly began screaming at the top of her lungs and would not stop. Best told Daly that she was going to be charged criminally for her behavior and that she was going to go to jail rather than Detox, as she was being too violent for Detox. Officer Gagnon and Officer Best then placed a Spit Net protective hood over Daly so she could not spit at officers.

Best reports that he, along with Officer Gagnon and Officer Vitale, stood Daly up after loosening her leg restraints, so she could walk to a wheelchair the officers had provided for her with the intention of bringing her to a squad car for transport to jail.

Best reports Daly stood in front of the wheelchair but would not sit down in the chair after she was ordered to do so and would simply tell officers that what they were doing was 'illegal' because 'she knows the law'. Best used his right arm and left hand and placed them on Daly's shoulder and upper chest area and pushed her down into the wheelchair while at the same time ordering her to sit down. Best reports as Daly was being wheeled out of the room, she continued to struggle with Best and Officer Vitale and Officer Gagnon. Best reports Daly then kicked at his groin area while she was sitting in the chair. Best reports he was able to block Daly's kick before her foot impacted his groin area.

Best reports Daly continued to struggle and he had to use an infra orbital nerve pressure technique in an attempt to force Daly to remain seated in the wheelchair. He reports she struggled the entire time and refused to follow any orders given to her by officers. Best reports she had to be physically picked up and placed in the back seat of the squad.

Officer Gagnon then transported Daly to the Blue Earth County Jail and Officer Best followed in another squad to assist. Best reports Daly had to be placed into a restraint chair upon arrival at the jail and also had to be placed in an isolation cell because of her violent behavior.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
