COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Innkeeper-defraud-obtain food or lodging without paying

Minnesota Statute: 327.75.1

Maximum Sentence:

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/08/2016 to 05/10/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16013864

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jeremy Douglas Attenberger, did obtain food, lodging or other accommodations at any hotel or restaurant without paying therefor, with intent to defraud the owner or manager, or who obtains credit for food, lodging or other accommodations at any hotel or restaurant with intent to defraud the owner or manager.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Bill Reinbold and others identified herein.

Officer Reinbold responded to a report of an individual defrauding an innkeeper over the span of several days, beginning on May 8, 2016, through May 10, 2016, at the River Hills Hotel in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Officer Reinbold reported to that location and identified the complaint as Witness 1. Witness 1 serves in the capacity as a manager at the hotel. Witness 1 indicated that another individual had rented a room but had not paid his most recent rental charges. That person was later identified as Jeremy Douglas Attenberger, the Defendant herein. Witness 1 reported that the Defendant had paid in cash in the past and that there had not been a problem until now. Witness 1 stated the Defendant had tried to pay with a credit card but it was declined. The Defendant later provided a check in the amount that was due. Witness 1 took the check to the bank in an attempt to cash it and determined that the account had been closed. Officer Reinbold determined that the checking account had been closed in December 2015.

A review of prior law enforcement records indicates that the Defendant has two previous offenses for Defrauding an Innkeeper in Blue Earth County in the last year. See Blue Earth County District Court File No. 07-CR-15-2658. Also a criminal history check reveals that the Defendant has been charged with Issuance of a Dishonored Check on five separate occasions in multiple counties.

The cost of reimbursement to the hotel is \$365.55. Restitution is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
