The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-3rd Degree-Substantial Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.223.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/28/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16005759

Charge Description: Hunter Andrew Friesen

On or about February 28, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Hunter Andrew Friesen did, assault another and inflict substantial bodily harm.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 28, 2016 at approximately 5:19 PM W1 called the Mankato Department of Public Safety and reported that his son, V1, had been the victim of an assault. W1 stated that V1 had told him that he was at South Street Saloon in downtown Mankato drinking with his friends the night before and was assaulted in the restroom.

V1 advised that he went into the restroom by himself and bumped into a guy by accident which caused the guy to spill his drink. V1 advised that the suspect punched him. V1 stated he went to the ground and believed that he was unconscious for a second or two. V1 advised that he has never seen the suspect before. V1 could not recall what the suspect was wearing but did recall that there was another person in the restroom who pulled the suspect off him. V1 stated that after the assault he got a cab and went home.

V1 stated he woke up the next morning and went to Mayo Clinic Health Systems to receive medical attention. V1's jaw is broken on both sides and a tooth is missing on his lower left jaw.

Officer Adam Kruger with the Mankato Department of Public Safety went to South Street Saloon to see if there was any camera footage of the incident. A bouncer advised Officer Kruger that he recalled a male matching the description of V1 near the restroom. The bouncer also stated that he remembers seeing W1 and W2 standing near V1. The bouncer advised that there is no surveillance camera that would show any altercation inside of the restroom.

Officer Kruger then located W1 and asked him about the incident that occurred at the bar. W1 stated that he walked into the restroom, turned and watched a kid (V1) get hit by his buddy. W1 stated that V1 fell into the door and that W1 grabbed him and stood him up and V1 then stated 'I didn't get knocked out.' W1 stated that V1 stated, before he was, punched, 'I bet you hundred dollars you won't knock me out.'

W1 stated that his friend, Hunter Andrew Friesen, is the one who punched V1. W1 stated that Friesen told him that V1 was holding his fist up to him as a joke and V1 said 'I bet you a hundred dollars that I could knock you out.' W1 stated that's when Friesen punched V1. W1 stated that he helped V1 out of the bathroom and V1 went on his way.

Officer Kruger then spoke with W2. W2 stated that he was extremely drunk and doesn't remember much of what happened. W2 stated that he recalled someone getting punched in the face and that he believes it was Friesen who punched V1.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
