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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Poss. Sch 1 or 2 Narcotic, LSD, MDA, or MDMA in School/Park/Public Housing Zone**

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(4), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$250,000.00

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/14/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16024148

Charge Description: Jacob Michael Freitag

On or about August 14, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jacob Michael Freitag did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period the person unlawfully possesses any amount of a schedule I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 14, 2016, at approximately 12:54 a.m., Officer Kruger of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was on downtown foot patrol when Officer Kruger was approached by staff of a downtown bar. The staff was escorting a male individual, who was later identified via Minnesota driver's license as Jacob Michael Freitag, D.O.B. 1-8-1982.

The staff member advised Officer Kruger that the staff member walked into the men's restroom and observed a male putting a white substance, which he believed to be cocaine, in the male's nose. The staff member advised Officer Kruger that the staff member then escorted the male over to Officer Kruger as Officer Kruger was nearby dealing with a different situation. Officer Kruger had the staff member complete a Declaration of Arrest.

Officer Kruger requested another officer come to Officer Kruger's location to assist. Officer Kruger then observed a white powdery substance, which appeared to be cocaine. Officer Kruger placed the male into handcuffs. Officer Kruger then searched the male and located the male's driver's license which identified the male as Freitag. Officer Kruger then field tested the white powdery substance, and the test indicated positive for cocaine.

Officer Sadusky took possession of Freitag's belongings and the suspected cocaine. Freitag was placed into Officer Sadusky's squad car and transported to the Blue Earth County Jail. Officer Kruger noted that the incident occurred across the alley from Jackson Park.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
