**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/11/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000473

Charge Description: Angeljo Marie Honetschlager

On or about March 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Angeljo Marie Honetschlager did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Domestic Assault-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/11/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000473

Charge Description: Angeljo Marie Honetschlager

On or about March 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Angeljo Marie Honetschlager did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

### COUNT III

**Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another**

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

On or about March 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Angeljo Marie Honetschlager did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

### COUNT IV

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting**

### COUNT V

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Offensive/Abusive/Noisy/Obscene**

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Charge Description: Angeljo Marie Honetschlager

On or about March 11, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Angeljo Marie Honetschlager did, in a public or private place, knowingly, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 11, 2016 at approximately 4:47 p.m., officers were notified of a domestic incident occurring at a residence in the City of Eagle Lake. Deputy Martin of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office was nearby and notified Dispatch that he would assist. Dispatch advised that the male and female involved were heading north on Agency Street. Dispatch further advised that the female was hitting and grabbing the male.

Upon arriving in the area, Deputy Martin located the male and female walking north on the 400 block of South Agency Street. He activated his emergency lights. Deputy Martin recognized the male, Victim, an adult male, from previous contacts. Victim was walking ahead of the female and the female was walking after him. Deputy Martin separated the individuals and identified them. The female was identified by Minnesota driver's license as Angeljo Marie Honetschlager, DOB 3-17-1980. Deputy Martin asked the male what was going on. Victim stated that he was trying to leave and get away from Honetschlager. Deputy Martin then had Victim sit on the curb as he briefly spoke with Honetschlager. Honetschlager advised that she paid Victim's bills and now they are having an argument.

Eagle Lake Police Officer Baynes arrived on scene. Officer Baynes spoke with Victim while Deputy Martin spoke further with Honetschlager. Deputy Martin asked her about the pushing that had occurred. She stated that Victim never put his hands on her and she never put her hands on him. Police Chief Kopp also arrived on scene. Chief Kopp spoke with Honetschlager while Deputy Martin called the complainant.

Deputy Martin made contact with the complainant, an adult male. The complainant advised that he saw the female hitting on the male and that the male was trying to walk away. He advised that the male threw the female's phone against the Eagle Lake sign. The complainant stated that they were arguing the entire time they were walking. Deputy Martin asked the complainant to elaborate what he meant by the female was hitting on the male. He stated that the female was grabbing onto the male and slapping at him. The complainant said the male was trying to get away from the female and kept yelling at her to get away from him. The complainant stated that the male was pushing the female away from him but that he felt the male was pushing her in a defensive manner due to her continually going after him. The complainant stated the male was continually telling the female not to touch him. The complainant advised that the male was talking on a phone and the female was continually grabbing at the phone. The male eventually threw the phone against the Eagle Lake sign.

Deputy Martin conferred with Officer Baynes and Chief Kopp. Officers then placed Honetschlager under arrest for domestic assault. Chief Kopp began searching her purse incident to arrest, prior to Deputy Martin transporting her to the jail. He located numerous clear, gem style baggies in the purse. He also found a plastic straw. The straw was cut at an angle and closed at one end. It was approximately two inches long. Deputy Martin recognized the straw as commonly used to scoop illegal narcotics out of containers or to snort illegal narcotics. Deputy Martin swabbed the pointy end of the straw with a NARTEC methamphetamine swab. The swab indicated positive for methamphetamine. He searched Honetschlager's wallet/clutch. In the compartment where cash is usually stored, he located a small, clear, gem style baggie with a white crystalline powder substance in it. Deputy Martin recognized it to be similar in appearance to methamphetamine. The items were collected as evidence and Honetschlager was transported to the Blue Earth County Jail and turned over to custody staff.

Deputy Martin later field tested the suspected methamphetamine that he had located using a NIK test. The test resulted in a presumptive positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

Officer Baynes asked Victim what had happened that evening and he said that he and Honetschlager had

gotten into an argument at home and he was trying to leave so the situation would not continue to escalate. He stated that she followed him and wanted to continue the argument. Officer Baynes asked Victim if Honetschlager had hit him and he stated that she had not. He stated she had only grabbed his coat to try to stop him. Officer Baynes confirmed that Victim and Honetschlager currently live together and are involved in a relationship.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
