The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2247.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/01/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16016144

Charge Description: Philip Lee Jacobson

On or about June 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Philip Lee Jacobson, did, assault a family or household member by strangulation.

COUNT II

Charge: Domestic Assault-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

On or about June 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Philip Lee Jacobson did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

On or about June 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Philip Lee Jacobson did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

COUNT IV

Charge: Damage to Property-4th Deg-Intentional Damage-Other Circumstances

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.3

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Charge Description: Philip Lee Jacobson

On or about June 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Philip Lee Jacobson did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 1, 2016, at approximately 12:26 p.m., Officer Lopez of the Department of Public Safety was informed of a domestic incident. The victim, an adult female ("Victim"), reported that her son had become physical with Victim and strangled Victim. Officer Lopez, upon arrival, made contact with Philip Lee Jacobson, D.O.B. 3-8-1987. Jacobson stated he had lost control and choked his mother. Jacobson stated he has mental health issues and had a breakdown. Officer Lopez placed Jacobson in the back of Officer Lopez's squad while Officer Hullopeter spoke with Victim.

Officer Hullopeter informed Officer Lopez that there was probable cause to arrest Jacobson for Domestic Assault by Strangulation after speaking with Victim. Officer Lopez placed Jacobson in handcuffs and transported Jacobson to the Blue Earth County Jail.

At the jail, Officer Lopez read Jacobson a Miranda warning; and Jacobson agreed to speak with Officer Lopez. Jacobson provided the following information: Jacobson had a mental health breakdown. Jacobson is struggling with depression. Jacobson overreacted to his mother not wanting to go home. Jacobson lost control and threw his pop at the car window. Jacobson became paranoid and was afraid of being in the car. Jacobson thought his mother was going to bring Jacobson to the hospital. Jacobson asked Victim to stop the car. Jacobson choked Victim to stop the car. Jacobson put his right hand around Victim's neck and squeezed lightly but was not trying to squeeze to hurt victim. Jacobson did it to get out of the car. Jacobson said Victim appeared to be afraid. This was the first time their argument had gotten physical. Other arguments had been verbal in the past. Jacobson indicated he has been diagnosed with a bipolar disorder, but he does not take medication for his mental health issues. Jacobson stated he was in Mankato to see his therapist for depression issues. Victim is Jacobson's biological mother. He lives with his mother and father in Waseca. The assault happened about an hour before the formal statement was gathered. Jacobson and Victim were on Highway 14 when they started arguing, and the assault happened in the parking lot of the Mankato Clinic. Jacobson threw his mother's phone against the wall of the Mankato Clinic entrance. Jacobson was afraid Victim would call someone and did not want Victim to have Jacobson taken away.

Victim stated that while Jacobson strangled her while they were in Victim's vehicle, Victim could not breathe. Officer Lopez noted Victim had red marks around her neck consistent with strangulation.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
