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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/01/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16019381

Charge Description: Justin Ryan Folson

On or about July 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Justin Ryan Folson did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Mankato Department of Public Safety Police Officer Adam Kruger states that on July 1, 2016, at approximately 8:51 p.m., he was dispatched to JC Penney in the River Hills Mall for a possible diabetic reaction in the fitting room. When he arrived, he made contact with personnel from Mall security, Gold Cross Ambulance, and fire individuals that were on the scene. He was advised that the male was in the fitting room for approximately one hour and was not making much sense. The male believed he was at Kohl's.

Officer Kruger located the male standing in the fitting room, speaking to a Gold Cross attendant. Officer Kruger asked what he was doing, and he stated he was trying some things on. The male was wearing a white t-shirt and, over the t-shirt, was a blue hooded sweatshirt. When asked if he had any ID, he stated he did not. When asked how he was going to pay for the merchandise, he pulled out some cash. Officer Kruger noted that the male had on multiple layers of clothing that the tags were still on them. He believed the male was attempting to shoplift.

Due to his strange behavior, he was placed in handcuffs for safety. He was identified by name and date of birth as Justin Ryan Folson. When the information was checked, the dispatcher advised Folson had a warrant for his arrest from Ramsey County for controlled substance.

Officer Kruger searched Folson and located a metal-like container in his pocket. Inside the container was a clear plastic baggie with a wax/oil-like substance inside. Through his training and experience, he believed that the substance was marijuana oil. The oil later tested positive.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
