COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/01/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16033279

Charge Description: Travis Ryan Eades

On or about November 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Travis Ryan Eades did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana and the person has been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 1, 2016, Agent Sam McGinnis of the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force was contacted by Mankato Department of Public Safety Officer Courtney Walker concerning a narcotics-related scene he was currently at. Officer Walker stated that he had accompanied Blue Earth County Probation Agent Steve Rick to do a probation check on Travis Ryan Eades, D.O.B. 8-30-1979. Eades is currently on probation with Agent Rick for multiple conditions, including felony Controlled Substance crimes. Agent Rick believed that Eades was under the influence when Agent Rick spoke with Eades earlier that day. Officer Walker, along with Agent Rick, went to Eades' residence at the Riverfront Suites in Mankato, Blue Earth County.

Officer Walker stated that upon arriving at the residence, Eades answered the door and informed Agent Rick and officers that he was not alone in the apartment. Also with Eades at the time was Kathleen Dianne Clark, D.O.B. 7-17-1988. Officer Walker located Clark in the bathroom and determined that Clark had an active warrant for her arrest. After arresting Clark, Officer Walker went back into the bathroom to do a secondary safety sweep where Clark had been hiding and observed a glass pipe with a white residue on it located on the bathroom floor. The pipe later tested positive for methamphetamine.

Agent McGinnis obtained a search warrant signed by The Honorable Kurt Johnson of Blue Earth County District Court. Agents executed the search warrant at the residence and located miscellaneous drug paraphernalia that included used baggies, which field tested positive for methamphetamine and were strewn about the main living area of the hotel room. The baggies were located close to the bed.

A record check revealed that both Eades and Clark have previously been convicted of felony Controlled Substance crimes.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
