COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Terroristic Threats-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/13/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15035836

Charge Description: Jordan Timothy Knutson

On or about November 13, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jordan Timothy Knutson, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 13, 2015, at approximately 10:50 a.m., officers with the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the Mankato hospital for a patient in the seclusion room who was threatening to kill staff members. Officer Gilbertson responded and made contact with Witness 1, an adult female, who told Officer Gilbertson the following information: Witness 1 was monitoring a patient, Jordan Timothy Knutson (D.O.B. 03/21/1985), today and Knutson was angry that Knutson was not allowed to listen to music. Witness 1 explained that the music had been taken away because it was not appropriate and feeding into Knutson's delusions. Knutson's nurse came into the room and tried to give Knutson medication. Knutson was reluctant to take the medication. While Knutson's nurse was in the room, Knutson kept asking, 'What do I have to do so you guys will kill me?' Knutson also said that Knutson was going 'blow this place up' and blow up all the TV's. Knutson then said that he will 'punch anyone I have to so that you can kill me.' Knutson's nurse left the room because Knutson's nurse feared for her safety due to Knutson's size, anger, and past violent history. Witness 1 attempted to talk to Knutson, and Knutson continued to become angrier and angrier. Knutson told Witness 1 that Knutson was going to kill Witness 1, and Witness 1 was afraid. Witness 1 had medical gloves in Witness 1's hand, and Knutson asked Witness 1 what she was going to do with those and if Witness 1 was going to kill Knutson. Knutson then said, 'All right, let's go!' After saying this, Knutson got off of his bed, pulled his sleeves up, and said he would 'fight all of you!' Knutson then postured himself in a fighting stance; and Witness 1 left the room, fearing for her safety. Knutson then started yelling that Knutson was going to 'blow this place up' and that Knutson would 'embalm them.'

Witness 1 was afraid and fearful of Knutson as Knutson's anger rose and he became more agitated. Knutson's nurse provided a written statement about the events that were similar in nature to what Witness 1 reported. Knutson was arrested and transported to the Blue Earth County Justice Center.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
