COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-5th Deg-Inflict or Attempt Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/23/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16015135

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Anthony Maurice Allen, Jr, did intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

COUNT II

Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/23/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16015135

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Anthony Maurice Allen, Jr, did in a public or private place, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know that it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Jake Green and others identified herein.

On May 23, 2016 at approximately 6:00 p.m., Officer Green responded to a report of assault at an apartment complex in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Officer Green reported to that location and identified three parties involved. The three were identified as Victim 1, Witness 1 and Anthony Maurice Allen, Jr., the defendant herein. Officer Green determined that Victim 1 and Witness 1 had been roommates together at a specific apartment at the complex. Officer Green determined that there was a dispute between Victim 1 and Witness 1. Witness 1 had been evicted from the apartment that she had been sharing with Victim 1. Victim 1 came home and discovered that her mail was on the ground. Victim 1 believed that Witness 1 had thrown her mail onto the ground. Both Witness 1 and the Defendant came to Victim 1's apartment together. Witness 1 and the defendant are girlfriend/boyfriend. Victim 1 and Witness 1 became involved in an argument. The altercation between Victim 1 and Witness 1 became physical. Victim 1 struck Witness 1. The defendant then became involved in a physical dispute with Victim 1.

Officer Green spoke with Victim 1 regarding the incident. Victim 1 admitted that she instigated the fight by punching Witness 1. Victim 1 claimed that the defendant became upset and began punching and kicking her. Officer William Hullopetter assisted in the investigation of the assault. Officer Hullopetter stopped a vehicle and located Witness 1. The defendant was not with Witness 1 when the vehicle was stopped. Witness 1 told the defendant what had happened and the defendant returned to the apartment to confront Victim 1. Witness 1 said that she did not know what happened between the defendant and Victim 1 because she wasn't there.

Officer Green spoke with Victim 1 regarding the incident. Victim 1 admitted that she struck Witness 1 in the back of the head. While Officer Green spoke with Victim 1, the victim pointed out that the defendant had poked his head outside of an apartment across the parking lot. Officer Hullopetter and Officer Green located the defendant sitting in the stairwell of another apartment complex across the parking lot. The defendant denied trying to hide from law enforcement but did not have a credible story as to why he was inside that specific building.

Officer Green spoke with the defendant regarding the incident. The defendant stated that he and Witness 1 went to the apartment. According to the defendant when they walked in, the victim threw mail into Witness 1's face. The defendant admitted that he began yelling at the victim. The defendant claimed that the victim punched him in the face. He acknowledged that he pushed the victim. The defendant said that the victim went face first into a wall. The defendant stated that both he and Witness 1 then left the apartment. Officer Green warned the defendant not to return to the apartment without a police escort. Officer Green also spoke with Victim 1 regarding the defendant. Officer Green instructed Victim 1 to contact law enforcement if the defendant returned to the apartment.

Approximately two hours later, the defendant returned to the apartment and Victim 1 called 911. Law enforcement determined that the defendant had broken into Victim 1's bedroom.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
