COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 10/17/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15013883

Charge Description: Daniel Michael Helget

On or about October 17, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Daniel Michael Helget did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 17, 2015, at approximately 7:11 p.m., Deputy Don Gabler with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office responded to a call of a trespasser on property owned by W1 and rented by W2. Both W1 and W2 stated that they gave no one permission to be on the property. W1 and W2 stated that they suspected that the person was Daniel Joseph Helget as they had had a problem with him in the past.

W2 stated that someone was in the field raking beanstalks. Deputy Gabler then spoke with Helget who admitted to going into the field and raking beanstalks. Helget admitted not having permission from either W1 or W2. Helget stated that he had done it in the past and would in exchange fertilize the field for W2. Helget stated that the bales from the beanstalks he used to cover his well for winter.

Deputy Gabler informed Helget that W2 was upset about what had happened. Helget stated he would apologize and return the five bales. Deputy Gabler made contact with W2 by telephone and stated that Helget had admitted to taking five bales' worth of beanstalks. W2 was still upset and wished to have Helget charged.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
