COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 2nd Degree - Sale 3 Grams or More - Cocaine/Heroin/Meth w/in 90-Day Period

Minnesota Statute: 152.022.1(1), with reference to: 152.022.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 25 years and/or \$500,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/26/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16012239

Charge Description: Daniel Samuel Edem

On or about April 26, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Daniel Samuel Edem did on one or more occasions within a 90 day period, unlawfully sell one or more mixtures of a total weight of three grams or more containing cocaine, heroin or methamphetamine.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 2nd Degree - Possess 6 Grams or More Cocaine/Heroin/Meth

Minnesota Statute: 152.022.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.022.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 25 years and/or \$500,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/26/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16012239

Charge Description: Daniel Samuel Edem

On or about April 26, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Daniel Samuel Edem, did unlawfully possesses one or more mixtures of a total weight of six grams or more containing cocaine, heroin or methamphetamine.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 26, 2016, at approximately 3:15 p.m., agents from the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force executed a lawful search warrant at 1209 North Seventh Street in Mankato, Blue Earth County. The warrant was signed by the Honorable Kurt Johnson of Blue Earth County District Court. Agents were searching the residence of Daniel Samuel Edem, D.O.B. 1-18-1990.

Upon arriving at the residence, officers made contact with two individuals inside. The individuals provided the location of Edem. Officers then began searching the residence. While searching one of the bedrooms, officers located an MSU Mav card belonging to Edem in the bedroom that was believed to be Edem's. Officers also found, in Edem's bedroom, two plastic baggies containing a white powder substance that field tested positive for cocaine and weighed approximately 7.1 grams. In addition to the cocaine, officers found an AWS digital scale, \$180.00 of US currency, a white measuring spoon with residue on it that field tested positive for cocaine, a glass block containing residue that field tested positive for cocaine, several baggies containing a small amount of purported marijuana that weighed approximately 11 grams, one tab of purported LSD that was packaged in a piece of tin foil, and several other items of drug paraphernalia, including plastic baggies, pipes, snort straws, etc.

Officers searched another bedroom that was believed to belong to Anthony Steven Pittman, D.O.B. 7-25-1991). Inside Pittman's bedroom, officers found several plastic baggies containing a brownish/white powder substance that field tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine. The substance was purported to be MDMA. The baggies weighed approximately 7.8 grams. Officers then found another plastic bag containing a brownish/white powder and rock substance that field tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine. The substance is purported MDMA and weighed approximately 2.1 grams. In addition, officers found several gem-style baggies containing residue that field tested positive for methamphetamine, a black measuring spoon containing residue that field tested positive for cocaine, a blue prescription pill identified as Amphetamine 20 mg, a black ceramic canister containing residue that field tested positive for methamphetamine, and several items of paraphernalia, including a digital scale, snort straws, plastic baggies, and smoking pipes.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
