COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Harassment; Restraining Order - Violate and knows of temporary or restraining order

Minnesota Statute: 609.748.6(b)

Maximum Sentence:

Offense Level: Petty Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028424

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jenna Marie Hiniker, did violate a restraining order issued under M.S. 609.748.

COUNT II

Charge: Obscene/Harassing Phone Calls-Repeatedly Calls

Minnesota Statute: 609.79.1(1)(ii)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028424

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jenna Marie Hiniker, by means of a telephone, did make or cause the telephone of another repeatedly or continuously to ring, with intent to abuse, disturb, or cause distress in any person at the called number.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Jessica Ellis and others identified herein.

On September 20, 2016, at approximately 12:27 p.m., Officer Ellis, of the Mankato Department of Public Safety, received a text message on her cellphone alerting her that she had a voice message. Officer Ellis then received a second text message regarding a second voicemail a short time later. The voicemails were checked at approximately 1:15 p.m.

Upon listening to the first voice message, Officer Ellis immediately recognized the voice as coming from Jenna Marie Hiniker, the Defendant herein. The first phrase starting the voice message reported, 'Hi. This is Jenna Hiniker.' The voice message continued making reference to apologizing for actions of the Defendant and the Defendant's desire to write a letter of apology to the department. The Defendant continues to discuss various religious beliefs, her experience in jail, and her current residence situation.

A second voice message began with the Defendant stating she had another thing to say to Officer Ellis. The Defendant's voicemail described a brief conversation the Defendant had with a male she encountered in the City of Mankato, who the Defendant alleged approached her for a sexual relationship. Both voice messages were downloaded onto a CD and placed into evidence.

Officer Sadusky and Officer Eggersdorfer drove to the Defendant's residence and attempted to make contact with the Defendant. However, the Defendant did not answer the door or was not at home. The phone number that the Defendant used to call and leave a voicemail with Officer Ellis was determined as a phone number belonging to Witness1 and Witness2, with an address in Blue Earth County. Blue Earth County Deputies were sent to the address in efforts to make contact with the Defendant for her arrest. Blue Earth County Deputies located Defendant and placed her in custody at approximately 2:30 p.m.

On April 25, 2016, the Defendant was served an Order granting a petition for Ex Parte Harassment Restraining Order in favor of the Petitioner, Mankato Department of Public Safety. The request for temporary relief was granted, and the Defendant was not to harass the Mankato Department of Public Safety and not to have direct or indirect contact with the Department of Public Safety; an emergency call was stated as an exception. The restraining order is in effective until April 22, 2018 and was in effect on the date of incident, September 20, 2016.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
