The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Predatory Offender-Knowingly Violates Registration Req. or Intentionally Provides False Information

Minnesota Statute: 243.166.5(a), with reference to: 243.166.5(c)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/02/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16022941

Charge Description: Timothy Todd Picard Also Known As Randall Blicke, Timothy Picard, Tim Todd Picard, Timothy Todd Pichard And Timothy T Picard

On or about August 2, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Timothy Todd Picard, did, as a person required to register under section 243.166, knowingly violated any of its provisions or intentionally provided false information to a corrections agent, law enforcement authority, or the bureau; and has previously been convicted of or adjudicated delinquent for violating this section or a similar statute of another state or the United States.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 2, 2016, at approximately 5:28 p.m., officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to an address in Mankato, Blue Earth County, on the report of a disturbance/assault. One of the people involved in that report was Timothy Todd Picard, D.O.B. 1-31-1962. A record check revealed that Picard is required to register as a predatory offender.

Picard had previously lived in California. Mankato Department of Public Safety records indicate that police had contact with Picard on July 9, 2016; July 21, 2016; and July 30, 2016. During all those contacts, Picard listed his address as homeless. During that time, Picard has not registered with the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension or the Mankato Department of Public Safety.

A record check revealed that Picard was sentenced for failing to register as a sex offender in California in 2013
