The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Abuse No Contact Order - Violate No Contact Order - within 10 years of previous conviction

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(c)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 12/20/2015

Charge Description: Jovan Marquese La-Shawn Carey Also Known As Jovan Marquese La Shawn Carey And Jovan Marquese Lashawn Carey

On or about December 20, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jovan Marquese La-Shawn Carey did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation occurred during the time period between a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency and the end of the ten years following discharge from sentence for that offense.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Audrey Kranz, a licensed police officer in the State of Minnesota, currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that on December 20, 2015, at approximately 5:19 p.m., she was informed by Blue Earth County Dispatch of a disturbance in the parking lot at River Bluff Apartments, located in the City of Mankato. It was reported that two males and two females were yelling and one of the males had grabbed a female's arm.

Upon arrival, Kranz met with the two females and was told the males had just left in a green Saturn passenger car. Kranz then advised other officers to check the area; however, the vehicle was not located.

Officer Kranz then identified the two females in this complaint as Adult1 and Adult2. Adult2 told Kranz that one of the males, identified as Jovan Marquese La-Shawn Carey, arrived with a friend named Dalton. Both Adult1 and Adult2 stated that Carey was instantly aggressive and got into Adult1's face after she told him to calm down.

Both Adult1 and Adult2 stated that he was upset because he couldn't see the daughter that he shares with Adult2 at that specific moment. Adult1 stated that Carey grabbed her arm, so she pushed him away. Adult2 stated Carey got into her face and was yelling and calling her names. Adult2 stated that during the incident, he grabbed her arm and threw a cigarette in her face as well. Both Adult1 and Adult2 stated they did not have any injuries.

Adult2 then stated Carey told her his cousin was coming for her and he and his friend then left. Adult2 reports she does not know which cousin Carey was referring to but did not feel the threat was credible.

Adult2 further reported that during the incident, Carey's friend, Dalton, had been trying to pull Carey back and was continually telling him to stop.

Adult2 stated she feels very upset and just wants Carey out of her life.

Kranz reports she then attempted to contact Carey but his phone was shut off. Kranz further reports she is aware that there is an existing domestic abuse no contact order which prohibits Carey from having contact with Adult2.

Additionally, Carey has previously been convicted of domestic assault as reflected in Blue Earth County court file 07-CR-15-916. Carey was sentenced for that offense on June 15, 2015.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
