COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Giving Peace Officer False Name-of Another Person

Minnesota Statute: 609.506.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/15/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16010358

Charge Description: Kueth Paul Ruae Also Known As Kueth Pamier Ruae And Kaeth Pamer Ruae

On or about July 15, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Kueth Paul Ruae did, with intent to obstruct justice, give the name and date of birth of another person to a peace officer when that officer makes inquiries incident to a lawful investigatory stop or lawful arrest, or inquiries incident to executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT II

Charge: Give Peace Officer False Name/Birthdate/ID Card

Minnesota Statute: 609.506.1

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/15/2016

Charge Description: Kueth Paul Ruae Also Known As Kueth Pamier Ruae And Kaeth Pamer Ruae

On or about July 15, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Kueth Paul Ruae did, with intent to obstruct justice, gave a fictitious name, other than a nickname, or gave a false date of birth, or false or

fraudulently altered identification card to a peace officer, as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, paragraph (c), when that officer makes inquiries incident to a lawful investigatory stop or lawful arrest, or inquires incident to executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT III

Charge: Liquor-Consumption by persons under 21

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.1(a)(2), with reference to: 340A.703

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/15/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16010358

Charge Description: Kueth Paul Ruae Also Known As Kueth Pamier Ruae And Kaeth Pamer Ruae

On or about July 15, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Kueth Paul Ruae did, while under the age of 21 years, consume an alcoholic beverage.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office Deputy Mitch Gahler states that on July 15, 2016, at approximately 7:35 p.m., he was dispatched to the Guaranteed Sand and Gravel in Blue Earth County in reference to two vehicles parked in the area and individuals possibly trespassing. Deputy Gahler arrived on scene and advised he would be on foot searching for the individuals associated with the vehicles.

He approached two individuals and explained that they were trespassing. They stated that they were swimming at the location and had been there multiple times with their friends. Deputy Gahler advised they were on private property and told them they would receive trespassing citations if they were ever found on the location again. Those two individuals advised that three other individuals were swimming near the back of the gravel pit and were getting ready to leave. Deputy Gahler noted that the two individuals left with the verbal warning without incident.

As he walked towards the back of the gravel pit, he observed two males and a female walking towards him. He advised them they were on private property and were trespassing. While speaking with the three individuals, Deputy Gahler smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from one of the males. The male stated that he was 21 years of age. The other individuals were asked for their identification, and one individual identified himself by name and date of birth as Gak Chamdk. The juvenile female provided a driver's license.

Upon running the information, the dispatcher advised that Gak had an active warrant for his arrest from Rice County. The individual, thought to be Gak at that time, was handcuffed and placed in the back of the patrol car. The individual then claimed that the person that had the warrant has a name spelling different than his and that he had the wrong person. Deputy Gahler advised him that they would straighten the issue out when they arrived at jail and conducted fingerprints so he could properly be identified. A preliminary breath test of the individual thought to be Gak, subsequently identified as Kueth Pamier Ruae, resulted in a reported value of 0.94.

While en route to the jail, Ruae continued to state that Deputy Gahler had the wrong person and he did not know where Rice County was located. When they arrived at the jail, he stated he wanted to be honest and he provided his real name and date of birth.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
