COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Poss. Sch 1 or 2 Narcotic, LSD, MDA, or MDMA in School/Park/Public Housing Zone

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(4), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/23/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028723

Charge Description: Jeremy Robert Thompson

On or about September 23, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jeremy Robert Thompson did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period the person unlawfully possesses any amount of a schedule I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/23/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028723

Charge Description: Jeremy Robert Thompson

On or about September 23, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jeremy Robert Thompson did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana and the person has been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

COUNT III

Charge: Drugs - Possession of Drug Paraphernalia - Use or Possession Prohibited

Minnesota Statute: 152.092(a)

Maximum Sentence: \$300

Offense Level: Petty Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/23/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16028723

Charge Description: Jeremy Robert Thompson

On or about September 23, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jeremy Robert Thompson did knowingly or intentionally possess drug paraphernalia; to wit: a snort tube.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 23, 2016, at approximately 12:13 a.m., officers with the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in the City of Mankato regarding a possible theft and disturbance. Officers arrived and spoke with the Complainants. Throughout the interview officers learned that an individual had just been at a residence at 321 1/2 North Broad Street and observed a large amount of methamphetamine. Officers were also advised that Erin Lea Janssen, date of birth July 24, 1978, was dealing methamphetamine from the upstairs apartment. Officers obtained a search warrant for the residence and arrived to execute the warrant at approximately 3:02 a.m.

Officer Green and assisting officers knocked and announced their presence and made entry. Officer Green entered the apartment and ordered everyone to the ground. There were several individuals inside the apartment including Janssen, Anthony Gene Barnes, date of birth June 21, 1965; and Jeremy Robert Thompson, date of birth December 19, 1978; in addition to others. While officers were attempting to detain Barnes, Barnes would not give up his right arm. Officers had to threaten to use force on Barnes several times before he finally complied. While officers searched Barnes to ensure he had no weapons, officers discovered a burnt glass pipe with white residue inside which later field-tested positive for methamphetamine. Officer Green entered a back bedroom and ordered Janssen and Thompson, along with another individual to put their hands on their head. They complied. The three were then detained in handcuffs.

Officer Green searched Janssen's left front pocket and found a small plastic bag containing a milky crystalized substance that later field-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed approximately .7 grams. In Janssen's right front pocket Officer Green found a small plastic baggy containing 12 white round pills that Janssen admitted were Clonazepam. Janssen admitted she did not have a prescription for the Clonazepam. Clonazepam is a Schedule IV controlled substance. When asked how much methamphetamine would be found in the apartment, Janssen advised that officers would find maybe 1/2 ounce. Officer Green learned from dispatch that Janssen had an outstanding felony warrant for her arrest. Janssen was then taken out to a squad car.

Officer Green searched Thompson and found a piece of a blue pen with white residue inside Thompson's left cargo pocket. Thompson admitted he used the pen to snort methamphetamine. In Thompson's right cargo pocket, Officer Green found a piece of a gray pen that had white residue inside. Thompson admitted that he used the pen to snort methamphetamine. Thompson was then taken out to the squad car.

During the search of the residence, the following items were located. A digital scale, an Excel energy bill with Janssen's name on it, an Altoid tin container containing 16 flash-drives and a small baggy with a white crystalized substance that later field-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighted approximately 1.1 grams, \$570 in US currency, a prescription pill bottle containing 42 Gabapentin pills, a plastic orange container with a white residue inside that later field-tested positive for methamphetamine; six corner-cut plastic bags, four glass pipes with a white residue all field-tested positive for methamphetamine, a small black blow-torch, two blue metal pipes with the odor of burnt marijuana, a small silver blow-torch, a black metal grinder with a small amount of a green leafy substance that later field-tested positive for marijuana, and an orange-colored tube connected to glass pieces on both ends used to smoke methamphetamine.

A copy of the search warrant and property receipt were left at the scene. Janssen was transported to the Blue Earth County Jail. Officer Green noted that 321 North Broad Street is one block west of Washington Park.

A review of Thompson's criminal history reveals the prior convictions in violation of Minnesota Statutes,

Chapter 152: Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, April 17, 2006 (07-VB-06-3088); Possession of Marijuana in a Motor Vehicle and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, August 4, 1998 (07-TX-98-003711); and Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, August 6, 2014 (07-VB-14-3127).

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
