The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer**

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

On or about November 6, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jon David Stolp did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

On or about November 6, 2015, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jon David Stolp, did, in a public place, while intoxicated, conduct himself or herself so as to be a danger to

themselves or others and/or engaged in public disruption.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 6, 2015 at approximately 10:26 p.m., Officer Price and Officer Mohamed of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the corner of Liberty Street and Broad Street in the City of Mankato regarding an intoxicated individual who was trying to get into a homeowner's residence.

On arrival, Officer Price made contact with a Jon David Stolp, DOB 1-12-1965, who indicated that he was trying to get to his friend 'Randy's' residence. Stolp said Randy lives on the corner of Liberty Street and Second Street. Officers drove to the corner and Stolp pointed to the residence where he believed Randy lived. Officers saw two people standing out in front of the residence and they informed officers that they don't know anyone named Randy. They informed them that Stolp came up to the residence and tried to enter without permission. They were able to flag down an officer and report the incident.

While speaking with Stolp, Officer Price detected a strong odor of a consumed alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. His eyes were watery and his words were slurred. Stolp submitted to a PBT and received a reading 0.254. Based upon Stolp's level of intoxication and the fact that he was unable to properly care for himself, Officer Price requested Blue Earth County Dispatch to contact New Ulm Detox so he could be cared for. Stolp was transported to the Public Safety Center to wait for Detox.

While waiting for Detox, Stolp was in the holding room, cursing at officers. Stolp said several times 'fuck you' and 'you fucking bitches are ruining my life.' Stolp also began slapping and kicking the holding room door. He was told multiple times to stop; however, he refused and continued hitting and kicking the door. Stolp's aggressive behavior continued to escalate. This caused concern because if allowed to continue, he could hurt himself. Officer Price entered the holding room and told Stolp to get on the ground but he refused. Officer Price grabbed onto Stolp and brought him to the ground to have a positional advantage over him, which would greatly decrease the chance of him causing harm to himself or Officer Price. Stolp refused to get on his stomach and yelled out several times 'no, fuck you.' Stolp tried to roll away from Officer Price and attempted to pull his arm away while Officer Price was trying to get his hands behind his back to be handcuffed. After a short struggle, Officer Price, with the assistance of Officer Mohamed, was able to handcuff Stolp. Based upon his aggressive behavior, New Ulm Detox would not take custody of him. He was detained in the Blue Earth County Jail.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
