The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Poss Dangerous Weapon/Explosive

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$35,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/15/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20024686

Charge Description: Maximilian Cengiz Orient

On or about October 15, 2020, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Maximilian Cengiz Orient did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the burglar possessed, when entering or at any time while in the building, any of the following: a dangerous weapon, any article used or fashioned in a manner to lead the victim to reasonably believe it to be a dangerous weapon, or an explosive.

COUNT II

Charge: Burglary-2nd Deg-Building-Possess Tool

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.2(a)(4)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years and/or \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/15/2020

Control #(ICR#): 20024686

Charge Description: Maximilian Cengiz Orient

On or about October 15, 2020, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Maximilian Cengiz Orient, did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice, and when entering or while in the building, did possess a tool to gain access to money or property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Officer Dan Best, a licensed peace officer in the State of Minnesota, currently employed by the Mankato Department of Public Safety, reports that he and other officers were dispatched to a residential apartment complex located in the City of Mankato.

When Best arrived on scene he learned that an individual identified as Maximilian Orient was being detained in the hallway of the apartment building and noted that Orient was bleeding from his hands.

Officer Mohamed then handed Best a Dunlop golf club which he stated he found in Orient's possession. Best noted that the shaft of the golf club had a moderate amount of what appeared to be fresh blood on it.

Officers then advised that Orient was a suspect for burglary in this case as he had entered the apartment building by forcing the garage door open and then entering the connected hallway of the building through a service door that connects from the garage to the hallway.

Officer Best further reports he discovered fresh blood on three other door handles in the hallway that connect to other garages.

Officer Best further notes a significant amount of blood was found on the back screen door of the patio of the apartment where it is believed that Orient used the golf club he had in his possession to smash out the door window to the inside door that leads into the residence from the patio.

An individual identified as Victim 1, who lives at the residence, was shown the golf club by Officer Best that was found in Orient's possession and confirmed that the golf club was Victim 1's and that it was discovered that it had been removed from his Dunlop golf bag which had matching clubs in it.

Best further notes that the golf bag was found located in this garage where Orient made entry.

Eventually, Orient was taken into custody and transported to the Blue Earth County Jail.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
