The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent
Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)
Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000
Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/27/2016 to 05/12/2016

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Alisha Marie Prouty, did intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In May 2016, Casey's General Store manager, W1, reported an employee theft that had occurred over the previous two months. Casey's is located at 2001 North Riverfront Drive in Mankato, Blue Earth County. W1 stated that he reviewed surveillance video and discovered that Alisha Marie Prouty, the defendant, would ring items up for customers then void the transaction and keep the cash. W1 verified by surveillance video that between March 27, 2016 and May 12, 2016, the defendant stole \$157.05 by doing this. Officer Lopez spoke with the defendant about the thefts and she admitted that she would line-void items for customers then use the cash to buy lottery tickets.
