The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess 50 or More Dosages Narcotic Mixture

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(3), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16014729

Charge Description: Michael Dean Olson

On or about May 20, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Michael Dean Olson did, on one or more occasions within a 90-day period the person unlawfully possesses one or more mixtures containing a narcotic drug, it is packaged in dosage units, and equals 50 or more dosage units.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Sale - Marijuana Mixture Except Small Amount of Marijuana with No Remuneration

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.1(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: not less than 6 months nor more than 10 years and/or \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16014729

Charge Description: Michael Dean Olson

On or about May 20, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Michael Dean Olson did unlawfully sell one or more mixtures containing marijuana or Tetrahydrocannabinols, except a small

amount of marijuana for no remuneration; and said defendant has a prior controlled substance conviction.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 20, 2016 Agent Sam McGinnis with the Minnesota River Valley Drug Task Force was contacted by Officer Katelyn Pierson of the Mankato Department of Public Safety concerning assistance with the narcotics -related scene. Officer Pierson was at the residence of Michael Dean Olson in the City of Mankato assisting the Blue Earth County Probation on a probation check. Olson is currently on probation.

While conducting the check, probation agents conducted a search of Olson's residence and located marijuana, numerous pills and a large amount of US currency in Olson's bedroom. Probation stopped the search and the scene was frozen pending a search warrant.

Agent McGinnis made application for a search warrant that was reviewed and approved by a judge of the Fifth Judicial District. Agent McGinnis and Lieutenant Wersal executed the search warrant. Numerous prescription medications were located mixed together in pill bottles. The prescription bottles were labeled and in the name of either Olson or Scott Abbe. Some of the medication was prescribed to Olson however the bottles contained a mixture of different medications. Purported marijuana was located near a digital scale and US currency.

Located in the bedroom of Olson's residence was the following:

- 12 suboxone sublingual film doses (schedule three controlled substance and semi-synthetic opioid)
- 4 pills Valium (schedule four controlled substance)
- 37 pills oxycodone (schedule two controlled substance and semi-synthetic opioid)
- 2 pills amphetamine dextroamphetamine (schedule two controlled substance)
- 16 pills morphine sulfate (schedule two controlled substance)
- 75 pills tramadol hydrochloride (schedule four controlled substance)
- 16 pills methylphenidate hydrochloride (schedule two controlled substance)
- 37.5 pills clonazepam (schedule four controlled substance)
- 1.25 pills carisoprodol (schedule four controlled substance)
- 1 pill Xanax (schedule four controlled substance)
- 9 pills zolpidem (schedule four controlled substance)
- digital scale
- black book containing drug notes
- \$3867.00 in US currency
- Gallon size Ziploc bag containing green leafy substance that field-tested positive for marijuana and weighed 94.3 g

A check of Olson's criminal history shows a prior controlled substance crime conviction which can be found in file 07-CR-13-3629. The conviction is for a 5th degree controlled substance crime from October 2013. It should also be noted that Olson has an open 2nd degree controlled substance crime case in Blue Earth County under file number 07-CR-16-423.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
