The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: False Imprisonment-Intentional Restraint

Minnesota Statute: 609.255.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/20/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15036670

Charge Description: Jason J Hayes

On or about November 20, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jason J Hayes did knowingly lacking lawful authority to do so, intentionally confined or restrained another person without that person's consent.

COUNT II

Charge: Stalking - Intent to Injure

Charge: Domestic Assault-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another

On or about November 20, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jason J Hayes did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Mankato Department of Public Safety Police Officer William Hullopetter states that on November 20, 2015, at approximately 7:31 p.m., he was dispatched to an address in the city of Mankato in reference to a domestic situation. The dispatcher provided information that someone was trying to get into the residence, and that the Victim locked herself in the bathroom. The dispatcher provided information that other roommates were actually home and the person in question was the boyfriend who just left.

Upon arrival, Officer Hullopetter knocked on the door and was greeted by Witness1 and Witness2. They took him into the room where the Victim was laying on the bathroom floor. The Victim appeared to be very upset and emotional. The Victim eventually stated she had an argument with Jason Hayes in her bedroom. She stated he isn't her boyfriend, but they had been exclusively dating since last summer. The Victim stated Hayes knows the whole police department so nothing would be done anyway.

Victim stated they were in her bedroom and Hayes saw text message on her phone to another male. He began extremely upset and started yelling at her. He called her such things such as a slut and a hooker and thought she was trying to sleep with other guys. She stated that they were arguing face-to-face and she told Hayes to leave. He stood in front of the door blocking it and she told him to leave at least 10 times, but he would not do so. She also stated that she wanted him to leave, but he would not move from the door.

She stated she pushed Hayes to get away from the door and he pushed her back and she fell onto the bed. She stated she tried to leave out the bedroom window, but he blocked her access as well. She then went into the bathroom and held the door shut. As the door did not have a lock on it, Hayes was pushing on the door to open it as well. She stated she finally gave up and let the door open. Hayes then yelled at her more and eventually left when she called the police. Witness1 and Witness2 then ran downstairs and locked the door and saw that the Victim was on the phone with the police.

Officer Hullopetter spoke with Witness1 and Witness2 who stated that Victim and Hayes fight all the time and he scares them. They stated that Victim and Hayes did not know they were upstairs and they heard them fighting so they went downstairs and audio recorded the fight through the door. Officer Hullopetter listened to the recording and heard Hayes screaming at the Victim and calling her names, alleging she was trying to sleep with other men. He also heard the Victim pleading with him several times to leave her house. He also heard two loud bangs which sounded like a door slamming or something hitting the door.

Officer Hullopetter made contact with Hayes via his cellphone and he refused to say where he lived or his current location. Hayes also would not meet with Officer Hullopetter. Hayes stated they had an argument because Victim was sleeping with other guys. Hayes admitted that he stood in front of the door and did not leave when asked because they were arguing. Hayes also admitted that he stood in front of the window and prevented the Victim from leaving.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
