The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 01/05/2016 to 01/05/2016

Control #(ICR#): 15060083

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Kyle Vincent Garmon, did unlawfully receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Bill Reinbold and others identified herein.

On January 5, 2016 at approximately 4:30 a.m., law enforcement discovered stolen property at a residence at 115 Echo Street in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Officer Bill Reinbold executed a search warrant at apartment #301. The search warrant was authorized due to an allegation of an armed robbery found in ICR# 16-349 involving individuals living at apartment #301. During the search, Officer Reinbold located two boxes of checks that had been reported stolen by a tenant living in the same apartment complex on Echo Street. The victim was identified as V1. The victim had reported the theft of the checks after they had been mailed to her on December 27, 2015. Two tenants were identified living in apartment #301. The two individuals were identified as Michael Lee Hence and Kyle Vincent Garmon, the defendant herein. Both Hence and the defendant had access to the stolen checks.

The Defendant is currently charged in Blue Earth County with Aggravated First Degree Robbery charges. See Blue Earth County District Court file 07-CR-16-44. The defendant also has a pending theft charge. See Blue Earth County District Court file 07-CR-16-417.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
