**COMPLAINT**

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-5th Deg-2/More Prev Convict in 3 years**

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/25/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16022095

Charge Description: Trevon Romelle Wynn

On or about July 25, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Trevon Romelle Wynn did commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within the previous three years.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk**

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/25/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16022095

Charge Description: Trevon Romelle Wynn

On or about July 25, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Trevon Romelle Wynn, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a

reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 25, 2016, at approximately 7:24 p.m., Officer Chris Baukol, with the Mankato Department of Public Safety, responded to Residence1, in the City of Mankato, for report of a threats complaint. Victim1 stated that the father of her child, Trevon Wynn, was at her residence threatening her.

On arrival, Officer Baukol could not locate Wynn. However, Victim1 and several of her friends were present. Officer Baukol knew the address of Residence1 had been the location that was searched earlier in the day and a suspect from an Owatonna incident involving a firearm was located there and arrested.

After clearing the residence, Officer Baukol asked Victim1 to step outside and explain what was going on. Victim1 stated that her house 'got raided' this morning and her child was taken away. Victim1 explained that Wynn is the father of their joint child. Victim1 stated that Wynn was upset with Victim1 because their child had been placed into protective custody. Victim1 stated in the morning she had spoken briefly with Wynn, and Wynn was asking where their son was.

Wynn ultimately hung up on her, then he sent her a text message stating, 'Bitch lma kill you bd dat nigga you got my son took while you at dis nigga court you stupid hoe.' The text was sent at 12:02 p.m. Victim1 stated this text message made her feel as though her safety was in danger. The text message came from a cellphone number that Wynn later provided to police officers as being his cellphone.

Victim1 explained she had gone to the Public Safety Center earlier in the day to find out about the status of her child. When she went there, Wynn was present, along with his sister. Victim 1 stated was threatened several times by Wynn where he told her things like he was going to 'beat her ass.' Victim1 stated that she was lead through a separate exit out of the Public Safety Center for her safety and so that she did not have to have any further contact with Wynn.

Victim1 also stated that later in the evening she was contacted by her neighbor who indicated that Wynn and his sister were at her residence trying to gain entry. This is when Victim 1 called and Officer Baukol responded to her residence.

After meeting with Victim 1 Officer Baukol cleared the location. Shortly after, dispatch received a call from Wynn requesting that an officer contact him. Wynn stated an officer could reach him on his cellphone. Wynn then provided the cellphone number that Victim1 had showed she had received the threatening text message from. Officer Baukol left a message on the voicemail. On the second time he tried contacting Wynn, the call went straight to voicemail as if it had been turned off. Wynn's whereabouts are currently unknown as he has no permanent address.

Based on the details of the investigation and Victim1's concern for her safety a Warrant is requested.

Defendant has multiple convictions for assault and/or domestic assault, including 2 within the last three (3) years:

Domestic Assault (Felony) found in court file 07-CR-14-4540; and

Domestic Assault (misdemeanor) found in court file 07-CR-15-1481.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
